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AMENDED NOTICE OF THE DAYTON POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY REGARDING COMPETITIVE BIDDING SCHEDULE

In light of the fact that The Dayton Power and Light Company ("DP&L") has filed a Stipulation and Recommendation, which will require testimony and a hearing, and the fact that the results of DP&L's most recent competitive bidding process ("CBP") expire on May 31, 2017 DP&L commits to hold a competitive bid process to be in place by June 1, 2017. As provided in the October 11, 2016 Amended Application of The Dayton Power and Light Company for Approval of Its Electric Security Plan and supporting testimony filed in Case No. 16-395-EL-SSO, and as modified by the Stipulation and Recommendation in the same, the competitive bid process will proceed as follows:

The initial CBP auctions will be conducted on April 3, 2017 and April 24, 2017. Each auction is for 50 tranches and each will offer products in varying product lengths of 12, 24, and 36 months. The delivery periods will align with the PJM calendar, with a delivery period beginning on June 1st of each year and ending on May 31st of the following year. See Attachment 1. Charles River Associates will serve as the auction manager.

Each tranche is a uniform 1% slice of the DP&L SSO load. The products are load-following, full-requirements service including energy, capacity, market-based transmission charges, and market-based ancillary services. As outlined in the Stipulation and Recommendation, renewable energy requirements will not be part of the bid product and will be procured by DP&L and with costs recovered consistent with the current process. Firm NITS and non-market based ancillary services are included in a different DP&L retail rate.

Unless otherwise amended above or by the Stipulation and Recommendation filed on January 30, 2017 in Case No. 16-395-EL-SSO, the bidder application and qualification process, bidding design, and post-closing process, will follow the same processes as set forth in the Direct Testimony of Robert J. Lee on in Case No. 16-395-EL-SSO.

DP&L will conduct a Percentage of Income Payment Plan ("PIPP") RFP process in the week following the April 24, 2017 CBP auction, pursuant to the Commission's Finding and Order on in PUCO Case No. 16-247-EL-UNC, and consistent with the methodology employed by other Ohio utilities.
