#### I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission grants the parties' joint motion to dismiss with prejudice, as the parties have resolved all issues and claims raised in the complaint.

### I. DISCUSSION

- **[¶ 2]** Pursuant to R.C. 4905.26, the Commission has authority to consider written complaints filed against a public utility by any person or corporation regarding any rate, service, regulation, or practice relating to any service furnished by the public utility that is in any respect unjust, unreasonable, insufficient, or unjustly discriminatory.
- $\{\P\ 3\}$  Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison or Respondent) is a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02 and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- {¶ 4} On September 9, 2016, M. Christos Makris (Complainant) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison alleging, among other things, that Respondent has both miscalculated Complainant's usage of electric service and overcharged Complainant for such service.

{¶ 5} On September 29, 2017, Ohio Edison filed its answer by which it admits some, and denies other the allegations of the complaint, and sets forth several affirmative defenses.

- {¶ 6} On January 13, 2017, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint. In the motion, the parties state that they have resolved all issues and claims raised in the complaint. Further, because no further action remains to be completed in this matter, and no further proceedings are necessary, the parties jointly request that this matter be dismissed with prejudice as a settled case.
- {¶ 7} In view of the settlement of the complaint, the Commission finds that this case should be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record.

## II. ORDER

- $\{\P 8\}$  It is, therefore,
- {¶ 9} ORDERED, That the joint motion to dismiss be granted and that Case No. 16-1864-EL-CSS be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,

{¶ 10} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
