I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission grants the applicant's request to withdraw its application and, as a result, dismisses this matter without prejudice, and closes this case of record.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} On October 6, 2016, TNE Telephone, Inc. (TNE) filed an application seeking authority to provide competitive local exchange telecommunications services in Ohio.

{¶ 3} On December 23, 2016, TNE filed a correspondence requesting that its application be withdrawn, so that this matter can be dismissed without prejudice, and that this case can be closed as a matter of record.

{¶ 4} The Commission finds that TNE's request is reasonable and should be granted.

III. ORDER

{¶ 5} It is, therefore,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That TNE's request to withdraw its application in Case No. 16-1999-TP-ACE be granted. It is, further,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That Case No. 16-1999-TP-ACE be dismissed without prejudice and closed of record. It is, further,


{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.


