In this filing, Champaign Telephone Company increases its BLES rate and related maximum residential local rate by \$1.25 per month in its Urbana, Kingscreek and Terre Haute exchanges effective June 1, 2017. (The local rate for business lines will not increase at this time.)

Champaign Telephone Company received BLES pricing flexibility, effective September 1, 2014, in Case No. 14-1196-TP-BLS. Champaign Telephone Company's last local rate increase was effective on June 1, 2016.

### **Customer Notice and Affidavit**

### (Customer Notice)

The following customer notice will appear on the bills that are mailed to customers on April 1, 2017. This notice will also be sent to the Office of Consumers' Counsel and to the Commissions' electronic mailbox (Telecomm-Rule07@puc.state.oh.us) no less than thirty (30) days prior to the rate increase.

Effective June 1, 2017, our local telephone rate for residential customers will increase by \$1.25 per month as listed in the table below. Many rural telephone companies, including Champaign Telephone Company, receive support from the Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF). New rules reduce such support if a telephone company's local rates are below the national average. The \$1.25 increase is necessary to bring our residential local rates more in line with the national average and to avoid reduction in our FUSF.
