Please accept this supplemental information, submitted on behalf of Budget PrePay, Inc. ("Budget PrePay") in connection with the Case referenced above in response to requests from the Commission Staff.

- Budget Prepay has not had any landline customers in Ohio since November 2015. Budget Prepay did not collect deposits from its customers and therefore has no deposits to return.
- Budget Prepay did not obtain numbers directly from the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA), and has no numbers to return upon discontinuing its operations.
- Attached is a copy of the Section 214 discontinuance filing submitted by Budget PrePay to the FCC.
- Budget Prepay will terminate its Interconnection Agreements with Frontier North, United Telephone Company of Ohio and AT&T.

SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

Budget PrePay, Inc. (“Budget”), by counsel, hereby submits this application (“Application”) to seek authorization pursuant to Section 214(a) of the Communications Act of 1934, 47 U.S.C. § 214(a), and Section 63.71 of the Commission’s Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue its provision of its domestic wireline telecommunications services (“Discontinued Wireline Services”) on or before May 31, 2017, in the following jurisdictions: Alabama, California, Delaware, District of Columbia, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Iowa, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, New Hampshire, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Rhode Island, Texas, Virginia, and Wyoming (“Wireline Jurisdictions”).

Budget does not provide wireline telecommunications services in any other states or other jurisdictions. Budget is a non-dominant carrier with respect to the Discontinued Wireline Services. Wireless services provided by Budget are not affected by this proposed discontinuance.

The impact on the public of this proposed discontinuance will be virtually non-existent because Budget currently has no customers for any of its Discontinued Wireline Services in any of the Wireline Jurisdictions. Because Budget operates as a non-dominant carrier with respect to the Discontinued Wireline Services, Budget anticipates that the Application will be automatically granted, pursuant to the provisions of Section 63.71(f) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(f), on the 31st day after the date on which the Commission releases a Public Notice specifying procedures and dates applicable to the Application.¹

In support of the Application, Budget provides the following information.

I. Information Required by 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(1) – 63.71(a)(4)

¹ Section 63.71(f) provides that:

The application to discontinue, reduce or impair service, if filed by a domestic, non-dominant carrier, shall be automatically granted on the 31st day after its filing with the Commission without any Commission notification to the applicant unless the Commission has notified the applicant that the grant will not be automatically effective. ... For purposes of this section, an application will be deemed filed on the date the Commission releases public notice of the filing.

2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance

Budget plans to discontinue the provision of the Discontinued Wireline Services on or before May 31, 2017, but, pursuant to the provisions of Section 63.71(f) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(f), no earlier than 31 days after the date on which the Commission releases a Public Notice specifying procedures and dates applicable to the Application.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected

Budget is planning to discontinue the Discontinued Wireline Services, as described above, in each of the Wireline Jurisdictions. Budget is following the applicable laws in each of the Wireline Jurisdictions for discontinuance of such services in each such jurisdiction.

4. Description of Type of Services Affected

As explained above, Budget will discontinue only its wireline services. Budget will continue to offer wireless services on a resale basis. The Discontinued Wireline Services consist of local and intrastate long distance wireline services provided to residential subscribers. Budget provides these wireline services pursuant to its domestic Section 214 authorization granted by operation of law pursuant to Section 63.01(a) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.01(a), as well as the requisite authorizations held by Budget in the Wireline Jurisdictions.

II. Notice to Subscribers

The notice requirements of Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a), relating to affected customers do not apply to the Application because, as explained above, Budget does not have any affected customers in the Wireline Jurisdictions.

III. Notice to Wireline Jurisdictions and to the U.S. Department of Defense

In accordance with Section 63.71(a) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a), Budget has mailed a copy of the Application to the public utility commissions and the Governors of the affected states listed above, to the public utility commission and the Mayor of the District of Columbia, and to the U.S. Secretary of Defense.

In addition, the following notice is hereby provided as required by, and specified in, Section 63.71(a)(5)(i) of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71(a)(5)(i):

The FCC will normally authorize this proposed discontinuance of service unless it is shown that customers would be unable to receive service or a reasonable substitute from another carrier or that the public convenience and necessity is otherwise adversely affected. If you wish to object, you should file your comments as soon as possible, but no later than 15 days after the Commission releases public notice of the proposed discontinuance. You may file your comments electronically through the FCC's Electronic Comment Filing System using the docket number established in the Commission's public notice for this proceeding, or you may address them to the Federal Communications Commission, Wireline Competition Bureau, Competition Policy Division, Washington, DC 20554, and include in your comments a reference to the Section 63.71 Application of Budget PrePay, Inc. Comments should include specific information about the impact of this proposed discontinuance.²

IV. Non-Dominant Status

Budget is a non-dominant carrier in the local and interexchange services markets, and, as indicated above, Budget operates as a non-dominant carrier with respect to the Discontinued Wireline Services.




