ANSWER OF OHIO POWER COMPANY

Ohio Power Company d/b/a AEP Ohio (“AEP Ohio” or the “Company”)¹ hereby responds to the complaint filed in this proceeding by Richard Burkart (“Complainant”) on March 23, 2017 (“Complaint”) through this Answer.

ANSWER TO ALLEGATIONS

1. AEP Ohio denies the allegation that Complainant was erroneously billed for electricity used due to a faulty meter for the period of December 1, 2016 to February 2, 2017.
2. AEP Ohio admits the dials on the meter were slightly misaligned. However, the meter accuracy tested within the applicable American National Standards Institute 2008 standards.
3. AEP Ohio denies any and all remaining allegations of the Complaint.

AFFIRMATIVE DEFENSES

1. AEP Ohio asserts as an affirmative defense that under Ohio Revised Code §4905.26 and Ohio Administrative Code Rule §4901-9-01(C)(3), Complainant has failed to set forth reasonable grounds for a complaint.

2. AEP Ohio, at all times, complied with Ohio Revised Title 49; Commission rules, regulations and orders; and the applicable Tariff.
3. AEP Ohio's meter accuracy, at all times, complied with the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) 2008 standards.
4. AEP Ohio reserves the right to raise additional affirmative defenses or to withdraw any of the foregoing affirmative defenses as may become necessary during the investigation and discovery of this matter.

CONCLUSION

WHEREFORE, Defendant Ohio Power Company respectfully requests that the Commission deny the Complaint in its entirety, and grant Ohio Power Company any further legal or equitable relief this Commission deems appropriate.
