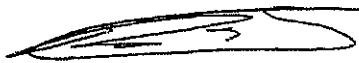

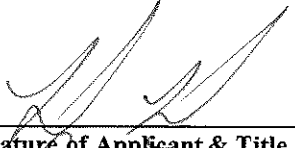

1. The applicant itself stating that it is investment grade rated by Moody’s, Standard & Poor’s or Fitch and provide evidence of rating from the rating agencies.
2. Have a parent company or third party that is investment grade rated by Moody’s, Standard & Poor’s or Fitch guarantee the financial obligations of the applicant to the LDU(s).
3. Have a parent company or third party that is not investment grade rated by Moody’s, Standard & Poor’s or Fitch but has substantial financial wherewithal in the opinion of the Staff reviewer to guarantee the financial obligations of the applicant to the LDU(s). The guarantor company’s financials must be included in the application if the applicant is relying on this option.

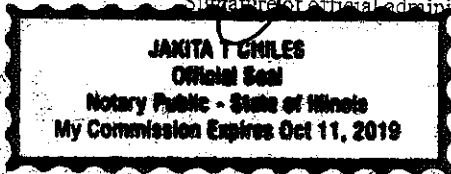

EXHIBIT B-2: EXPERIENCE AND PLANS

As a standard practice and in compliance with all jurisdictions in which the Alfa Energy LLC is licensed, the Alfa Energy LLC provides its prospective clients with adequate, accurate, and understandable pricing and terms and conditions of service, including any switching fees, and a document containing the terms and conditions of pricing and service before the consumer enters into the contract for service, and discloses the conditions under which a customer may rescind a contract without penalty. All prospective clients are also informed as to the procedure as to how a client may cancel, switch or terminate service, and the requisite notice for such cancellation.

Alfa Energy LLC discloses of all prices, commissions earned on the transaction, usage history, and information relating to the suppliers in which Alfa Energy LLC is offering energy brokerage services through. Alfa Energy LLC provides all contact information to the supplier that is selected for service for direct contact and issues relating to the provision of service, as well as the contact information of the governing body of the energy market (i.e. Illinois Commerce Commission in Illinois). Alfa Energy LLC also assigned a trained sales member to each customer to assist in the servicing of the customer throughout the duration of the contract with Alfa Energy LLC.

Alfa Energy LLC customers receive monthly or quarterly (at the selection of the customer) statements showing usage, rates and commission earned.

In order to comply with Section 4928.10 of the Ohio Revised Code, Alfa Energy LLC has recently adopted the practice of providing customers with information pertaining to the following:

- Coordination between suppliers for the purpose of maintaining service;
- The allocation of partial payments between suppliers when service components are jointly billed;
- A prohibition against blocking, or authorizing the blocking of, customer access to a noncompetitive retail electric service when a customer is delinquent in payments to the electric utility or electric services company for a competitive retail electric service;
- A prohibition against switching, or authorizing the switching of, a customer's supplier of competitive retail electric service without the prior consent of the customer in accordance with appropriate confirmation practices, which may include independent, third-party verification procedures.
- A requirement of disclosure of the conditions under which a customer may rescind a decision to switch its supplier without penalty;
- Specification of any required notice and any penalty for early termination of contract.

Alfa Energy LLC has and will continue to comply with all regulations set forth by the governing jurisdictions, including those regulations set forth in Section 4928.10 of the Ohio Revised Code.

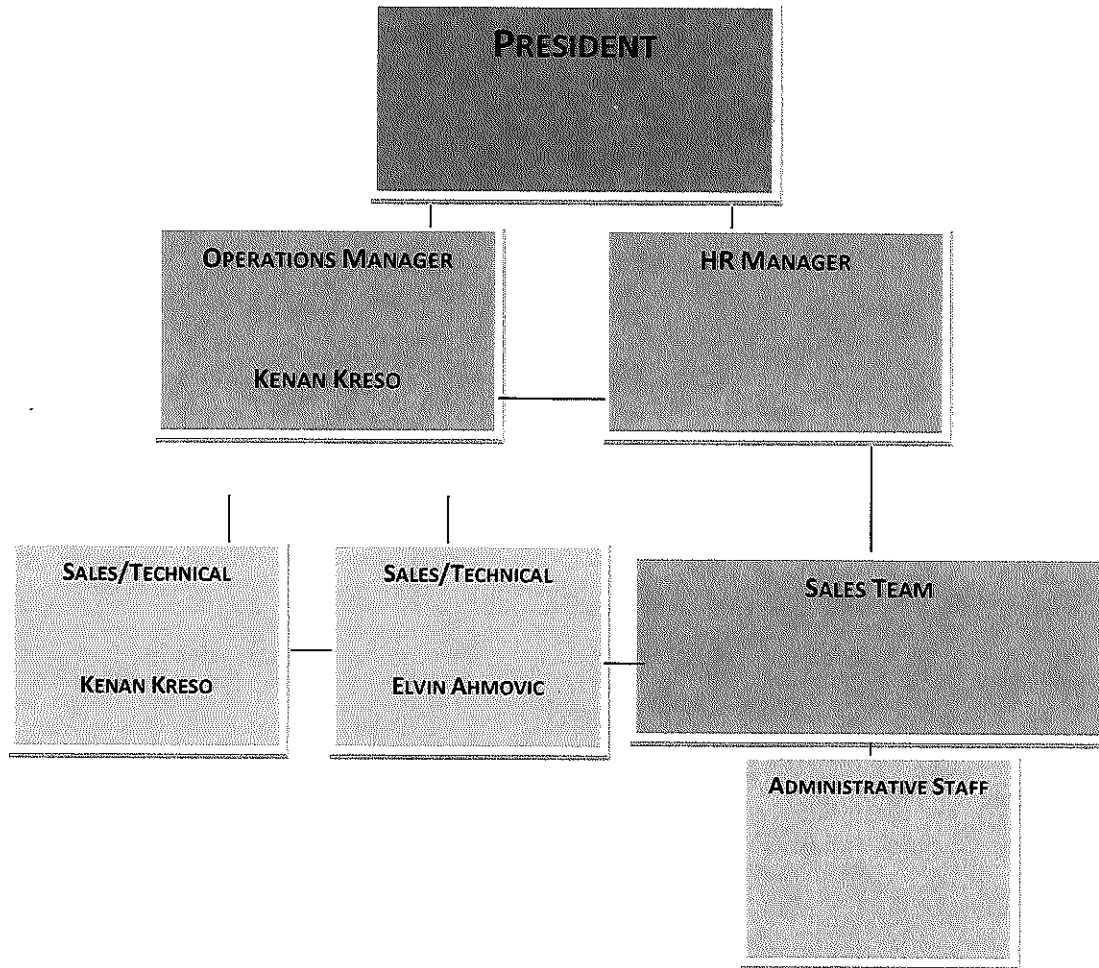
