(Description of Changes)

In this application, Arthur Mutual Telephone Company increases its BLES rates for residential customers by \$2.00 per month and business customers by \$1.25 per month, effective June 1, 2017. By doing so, the Company is in line with the revised universal service "urban rate floor" set in accordance with the FCC's Report and Order and Further Notice of Rulemaking, WC Docket Nos. 10-90, et.al., FCC 11-161 (Released November 18, 2011). The FCC Order on May 18, 2017, adopting a frozen rate floor of \$18, will apply to support reductions for the period July 2017 through June 2018. A customer notice needed to be sent out in April moving toward the established rate floor of \$20 for High Cost Loop Support by June 1, 2017.

The following customer notice appeared as a bill message that was mailed to Arthur Mutual Telephone Company customers on April 27, 2017. This notice was also sent to the Commission's electronic mailbox (<u>Telecomm-Rule07@puc.state.oh.us</u>) and to the Office of Consumers' Counsel (<u>occtelco@occ.state.oh.us</u>).

Effective June 1, 2017, our local rates for residential telephone service will increase from \$18.00 to \$20.00 and from \$26.40 to \$27.65 for business service. The increase is necessary to bring our local rates more in line with the national average and to move toward the revised universal service urban rate floor set in accordance with the FCC's Report and Order and Further Notice of Rulemaking, WC Docket Nos. 10-90, et.al., FCC 11-161.
