Re: PUCO Case No. 17-1210-RR-FED- In the Matter of the Request of Norfolk Southern Railway Company to Relocate the Existing Warning Devices at the Wilkins Road/CR 108 Grade Crossing (DOT#509-474W) in Lucas County, Ohio.

On May 8, 2017, Norfolk Southern Railway Company (NS) filed a request to relocate existing warning devices at the Wilkins Road/CR 108 Grade Crossing (DOT#509-474W) in Lucas County, Ohio.

Rail staff conducted a field review of the crossing in the request. On June 20, 2017, Staff filed a staff report that outlined the following recommendations:

- 1) Approve the warning device modifications since the new placement will conform to OMUTCD standards and will not create any visual hazards for motorists using the crossing.
- 2) NS should complete this work within 6 months of the Commission authorization.

Upon further review of the recommendations, Staff is now requesting/recommending that NS complete the work within 3 months of the Commission authorization.
