**MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE
ON BEHALF OF THE STAFF OF THE
PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO**

The Transportation Staff of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio respectfully requests that the date for the evidentiary hearing in this matter be continued. Hearing is presently scheduled to begin July 13, 2017. Staff makes this request pursuant to O.A.C. 4901-1-13(A) due to scheduling conflicts and the demands of other business.

Specifically, Staff presently intends to call two expert witnesses in addition to the inspecting officer and a compliance officer. At least one of those experts is unavailable on the currently scheduled hearing date. The same said witness is scheduled for jury duty during the month of August.

Staff requests that the hearing be scheduled for a mutually agreeable date in September, 2017. Staff for Staff has scheduling conflicts throughout the month of August that preclude rescheduling before September.

In addition, Respondent has indicated to the bench that it intends to retain counsel, but has not yet done so. A continuance will give Respondent ample opportunity to secure counsel and adequately prepare for hearing.
