NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY


AEP Ohio Transmission Company Inc. (AEP Ohio Transco) an affiliate of AEP Ohio proposes to build a new 345-kilovolt (kV) to 138 kV substation in Washington Township in Monroe County. The project is known as the Lamping Station Project.

The project will provide a new power source and improve reliability of the electric transmission grid in Marietta and the surrounding area. The approximate 5-acre substation will be built on property currently owned by AEP Ohio. The property is near an existing 345 kV transmission line. This project will be an approximate \$30 million investment by AEP Ohio. Construction is scheduled to begin fall 2017.

AEP Ohio Transco filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB), under Case No. 17-0810-EL-BLN. This number should be included in all communications related to this project. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility is pending before the OPSB.

Petitions to intervene in the Letter of Notification will be accepted by the OPSB up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice required by Rule 4906-2-12, Ohio Administrative Code. Petitions should be addressed to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793 and must cite Case No. 17-0810-EL-BLN.
