Summary: USDA Rural Development has made a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) with respect to a request for possible financing assistance to the Village of Woodsfield for the construction of a partial Storm Sewer Separation in the Village of Woodsfield.

Supplementary Information: The proposed project will begin a partial Storm Sewer Separation project in Woodsfield, Ohio. Alternatives considered by USDA Rural Development and the Village of Woodsfield include:

The alternatives are discussed in the Village of Woodsfield EA. The USDA Rural Development has reviewed and approved the EA for the proposed project.

The availability of the EA for public review was announced via notice in the following newspaper(s): *The Monroe County Beacon* for two consecutive weeks on/or after May 11. A 14-day comment period was announced in the newspaper notice. The EA was also available for public review at Woodsfield's Village Hall, 221 South Main

Street, Woodsfield, Ohio 43793. No comments were received. Based on its EA, commitments made by the Village of Woodsfield and lack of public comments received, USDA Rural Development has concluded that the project would have no significant impact to water quality, wetlands, floodplains, land use, aesthetics, transportation, or human health and safety.

The proposed project will have no adverse effect on resources listed or eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The Agency has also concluded that the proposed project is not likely to affect federally listed threatened and endangered species or designated critical habitat thereof. The proposed project would not disproportionately affect minority and/or low-income populations. No other potential significant impacts resulting from the proposed project have been identified. Therefore, USDA Rural Development has determined that this FONSI fulfills its obligations under the National Environmental Policy Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.), the Council on Environmental Quality Regulations (40 CFR §§ 1500-1508), and USDA Rural Development's Environmental Policies and Procedures (7 CFR Part 1970) for its action related to the project.

USDA Rural Development is satisfied that the environmental impacts of the proposed project have been adequately addressed. USDA Rural Development's federal action would not result in significant impacts to the quality of the human environment, and as such it will not prepare an Environmental Impact Statement for its action related to the proposed project.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

AEP Ohio Transmission Company Inc. (AEP Ohio Transco) an affiliate of AEP Ohio proposes to build a new 345-kilovolt (KV) to 138 KV substation in Washington Township in Monroe County. The project is known as the **Lamping Station Project**.

The project will provide a new power source and improve reliability of the electric transmission grid in Marietta and the surrounding area. The approximate 5-acre substation will be built on property currently owned by AEP Ohio. The property is near an existing 345 KV transmission line. This project will be an approximate \$30 million investment by AEP Ohio. Construction is scheduled to begin fall 2017.

AEP Ohio Transco filed a Letter of Notification with the Ohio Power Siting Board (OPSB), under Case No. **17-0810-EL-BLN**. This number should be included in all communications related to this project. The Letter of Notification to construct, operate and maintain this facility is pending before the OPSB.

Petitions to intervene in the Letter of Notification will be accepted by the OPSB up to 10 days following the publication date of this notice required by Rule 4906-2-12, Ohio Administrative Code. Petitions should be addressed to Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio, 43215-3793 and must cite Case No. 17-0810-EL-BLN.

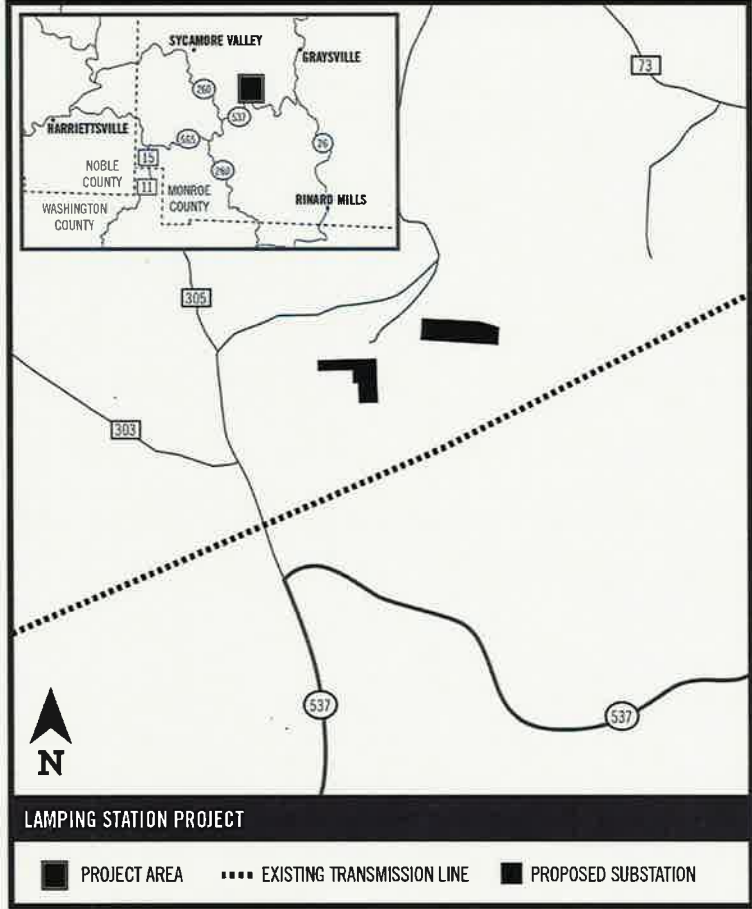
