



SUMMARY

On March 31, 2017, Orwell – Trumbull Pipeline Company, LLC. (OTP or Company) filed an application seeking approval of an interruptible transportation agreement with Gas Natural Resources, LLC (GNR).

The agreement provides for the transportation of customer owned gas from OTP's interconnects with intrastate pipelines and local production to delivery points with local distribution companies and end users. *The agreement includes transportation rates, late payment fees, and imbalance and cash out provisions.* The initial term of the agreement is for two years and year to year thereafter unless terminated in writing six months prior to the end of term.

STAFF REVIEW

Staff reviewed the application filed in the above case and finds the agreement to be reasonable.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends, to the Commission, that the application filed by OTP be approved.
