P.U.C.O. NO. 1 ACCESS SERVICE TARIFF

IDENTIFICATION AND RATING OF TOLL VOIP - PSTN TRAFFIC

(1) Scope

> This section governs the identification of Toll VoIP-PSTN Traffic that is required to be compensated at interstate access rates (unless the parties have agreed otherwise) as mandated by the Federal Communications Commission in its Report and Order in WC Docket Nos. 10-90, etc., FCC Release No. 11-161 on November 18, 2011 ("FCC Order") and the FCC's Second Order of Reconsideration (12-47) released April 25, 2012. Specifically, this section establishes the method of separating Toll VoIP-PSTN Traffic from the customer's traditional intrastate access traffic, so that such traffic can be billed in accordance with the FCC Order.

- (2)Rating of Toll VoIP-PSTN Traffic
 - (a) **Terminating** The Toll VolP-PSTN Traffic - terminating identified in accordance with this tariff section will be billed at rates equal to the Telephone Company's applicable tariffed interstate terminating switched access rates as specified in Section 17 of the National Exchange Carrier Association Tariff F.C.C. No. 5.
 - Originating The Company's aggregate intrastate originating switched access rates are lower than their aggregate interstate originating switched access rates. All intrastate originating traffic will be billed at intrastate originating switched access rates.
- Calculation and Application of Percent-VoIP-Usage Factor (3)
 - The Telephone Company will determine the number of terminating intrastate Toll VolP-PSTN Traffic minutes of use (MOU) to which interstate rates will be applied under (2). preceding, by applying a terminating PVU factor that represents the total intrastate access MOU that is originated by the Customer's end user in IP format and delivered to the Telephone Company and the total intrastate access MOU originated by the Customer enduser and terminated by the Telephone Company in IP format to the total intrastate access MOU
 - The Telephone Company will determine the portion of dedicated facilities to which interstate rates will be applied under (2), preceding, by applying a PVU factor for dedicated switched access facilities to the dedicated facilities between the Telephone Company and the Customer.
 - The Telephone Company will determine the number of originating intrastate Toll VolP-PSTN Traffic minutes of use (MOU) to which interstate rates will be applied under (2), preceding, by applying an originating Percent VolP Usage (PVU) factor to the total intrastate access MOU originated by a Telephone Company end user and delivered to the customer.
 - The Customer will calculate and furnish to the Telephone Company a terminating PVUC factor (along with the supporting documentation as specified in (3)(j) below) representing the whole number percentage of the Customer's total terminating intrastate access MOU that the Customer exchanges with Telephone Company in the state that is sent to the Telephone Company and which originated in IP format and that would be billed by the Telephone Company as intrastate terminating access MOU.
