Gentlemen:

As citizens of Ohio, we would like to express our enthusiastic support for the Icebreaker Windpower, Inc. proposal to build a pilot wind farm in Lake Erie. This proposal to build 6 turbine wind farm, 8 – 10 miles from Cleveland would be large enough to prove the concept that safe wind turbines can be built and can stand up to lake currents and ice floes. It will also demonstrate economic feasibility of generating useful electrical power.

If expanded, it could represent a very significant stimulus to the economy of Northeast Ohio. It could also address perhaps the most challenging need for Ohio's future: environmentally safe electrical power.

Federal studies have found that the "best winds" for wind turbines are found over Lake Erie.


