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4 1 Tuesday Morning Session, 2 August 29, 2017. 3 4 EXAMINER SCHABO: Let's go on the record 5 then. The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio 6 7 has called for hearing at this time and place Case No. 17-210-GA-GCR, 17-310-GA-UEX, and 17-410-GA-PIP 8 9 entitled in the Matter of the Regulation of the Purchased Gas Adjustment Clauses Contained Within the 10 11 Rate Schedules of Glenwood Energy of Oxford, Inc.; in 12 the Matter of the Regulation of the Uncollectible 13 Expense Riders of Glenwood Energy of Oxford, Inc.; 14 and in the Matter of the Percentage of Income Payment 15 Plan Rider of Glenwood Energy of Oxford, Inc., 16 respectively. 17 My name is Patricia Schabo and with me is 18 Greta See and we are the Attorney Examiners assigned 19 by the Commission to hear this case. 20 I would like to begin by taking 21 appearances of counsel on behalf of the parties. 22 MR. HOWARD: Your Honor, if it please the 23 Commission, would you have the record reflect the 24 appearance of the law firm of Vorys, Sater, Seymour 25 and Pease, 52 East Gay Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215

MARGARD: Your Honor, on behalf of the staff of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio, 4 5 Mike DeWine, Ohio Attorney General, William L. 6 Wright, Section Chief of the Public Utilities 7 Section, by Assistant Attorney General Werner L. 8 Margard, 30 East Broad Street, 16th Floor, Columbus, 9 Ohio. 10 EXAMINER SCHABO: Thank you. 11 Are there any interested parties or 12 members of the public present who wish to identify 13 themselves for the record? 14 Please let the record reflect there are 15 no members of the public present. 16 I understand there is a stipulation? MR. MARGARD: There is, your Honor. And 17 18 staff is prepared to present a witness in support of 19 the stipulation. Preliminary to that, however, I 20 have a number of documents that I have premarked 21 prior to the hearing consistent with that 22 stipulation. 23 First of all, I will note that I have 24 provided the stipulation which I have marked as Joint 25 Exhibit No. 1. I have also marked as

11	the period of January 2015 through December 2016
12	docketed in on June 30 of 2017; and as
13	Commission-Ordered Exhibit No. 3, report by the staff
14	of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio being the
15	Audit of the Percentage of Income Payment Plan
16	Mechanisms for Glenwood Energy of Oxford, Inc., for
17	the period January 2015 through December 2016 also
18	docketed on June 30 of 2017.
19	MR. HOWARD: Your Honor, at this time I
20	would like the Bench to mark as Glenwood Exhibit 1 a
21	two-page document being the proof of publication of
22	the GCR hearing in this matter. Please note that the

23 legal notice was published in a newspaper of general 24 circulation in Butler County on July 9.

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On August 24, I filed a motion for

1	partial waiver to request that the Commission waive
2	that portion of the rule that limited publication to
3	take place no earlier than 30 days prior to the
4	hearing. We filed that on August 24 and served that
5	on the staff. We would ask you, the Bench, today or
6	through the body of the opinion and order that would
7	be issued ultimately in this case to grant that
8	motion for partial waiver. Thank you.
9	Oh, and let me also add that the
10	newspaper notice was made for all customers on
11	July 9. To the extent the stipulation reflects that
12	the notice was done by bill message, we would ask
13	that the stipulation be modified accordingly. Thank
14	you.
15	MR. MARGARD: Your Honor, staff has no
16	objection to the motion. Furthermore, staff has no
17	objection to the modification in the stipulation.
18	EXAMINER SCHABO: Thank you, Mr. Margard.
19	We will go ahead and let the Commission rule on both
20	the motion and the request to modify the stipulation
21	in the body of the upcoming order.
22	MR. HOWARD: Thank you, your Honor.
23	EXAMINER SCHABO: And assuming there are
24	no objections to each other's request for marking
25	I'm sorry. The exhibits will be marked as requested.

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8 1 (EXHIBITS MARKED FOR IDENTIFICATION.) EXAMINER SCHABO: Mr. Margard, would you 2 like to proceed with your witness. 3 MR. MARGARD: Thank you, your Honor. 4 5 Staff would like to call Roger Sarver to the stand. EXAMINER SCHABO: Good morning, 6 7 Mr. Sarver. Raise your right hand. (Witness sworn.) 8 9 EXAMINER SCHABO: Wonderful. Thank you 10 very much. Have a seat. If you could state your 11 name and business address for the record, please. 12 THE WITNESS: Roger Sarver, my business 13 address is 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. 14 15 EXAMINER SCHABO: Mr. Margard. 16 MR. MARGARD: Thank you, your Honor. 17 18 ROGER SARVER 19 being first duly sworn, as prescribed by law, was 20 examined and testified as follows: 21 DIRECT EXAMINATION 22 By Mr. Margard: 23 Mr. Sarver, do you have before you what Q. 24 has been marked as Commission-Ordered Exhibits 1, 2, 25 and 3?

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1	A. Yes, I do.
2	Q. And are you familiar with those
3	documents?
4	A. Yes, sir.
5	Q. And did you have any involvement in
6	conducting the audits or preparing the reports that
7	are marked as Commission-Ordered Exhibits 1, 2, and
8	3?
9	A. Yes, I was responsible for all these
10	audits.
11	Q. Do you have any changes, corrections,
12	modifications of any kind to any of those exhibits
13	today as you testify?
14	A. No, sir.
15	Q. Thank you. And are they true and
16	accurate to the best of your knowledge and belief?
17	A. Yes.
18	Q. Thank you. Do you also have before you a
19	copy of Joint Exhibit 1, the stipulation filed in
20	this case?
21	A. Yes, sir.
22	Q. And are you familiar with that document
23	as well?
24	A. Yes.
25	Q. And have you had occasion to have

discussions with representatives of the company with 1 2 respect to its contents? 3 Yes, sir. The stipulation was discussed Α. with members of Glenwood and consensus was reached 4 5 that the findings in the staff report would be 6 acceptable by the company, and so the stipulation 7 adopted the findings in the staff reports. In their entirety; is that correct? 8 Q. 9 Α. Yes, sir. 10 Thank you. In your opinion, Mr. Sarver, Q. is this settlement a product of serious bargaining 11 12 among capable and knowledgeable parties? 13 Α. Yes, sir. 14 Have you experience negotiating such Ο. 15 agreements in the past? 16 Α. Yes. 17 And to the best of your knowledge, have Q. 18 representatives of Glenwood had similar experience? 19 Α. Yes. Staff has worked with these staff 20 members of Glenwood for approximately the last 10 21 years. 22 Thank you. In your opinion, Mr. Sarver, Ο. 23 does this settlement as a package benefit ratepayers 24 and public interest? 25 Α. Yeah. The purpose of these audits is to

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11 verify the costs that the company incurs to provide 1 2 the services of the gas cost recovery mechanism, the uncollectible, and the PIPP. Staff in its audits 3 found some minor errors that were adjusted, and the 4 5 company has accepted those adjustments. 6 Thank you. Mr. Sarver, in your opinion, Ο. 7 does this settlement violate any important regulatory principles or practices? 8 9 Α. No, sir. 10 Thank you. And as a final matter, you Q. 11 are aware that the company completed notice of this 12 hearing by publication rather than by insert? 13 Α. That I became aware of today, yes. 14 In your opinion has the public received Ο. 15 adequate notice of this hearing? 16 Yes. A lot of the utilities will Α. 17 function by publishing their notices in newspapers. 18 Some smaller utilities will do it by bill inserts if 19 they have got a very diverse or dispersed service 20 area. But for Glenwood since they are primarily the 21 city of Oxford, all of those customers are in the 22 immediate vicinity, and publication in this form would notice all customers. 23 24 Satisfactory in staff's opinion? 0. 25 Α. Yes.

12 1 MR. MARGARD: Thank you. 2 I have no further questions of this 3 witness, your Honor. EXAMINER SCHABO: Mr. Howard? 4 5 MR. HOWARD: No questions. Thank you, 6 your Honor. 7 EXAMINER SCHABO: Thank you, Mr. Sarver. 8 You may step down. 9 MR. MARGARD: Your Honor, I have no 10 further witnesses and would respectfully move the 11 admission of Commission-Ordered Exhibits 1, 2, and 3 12 and would further move for the admission of Joint 13 Exhibit No. 1. 14 EXAMINER SCHABO: Okay. Mr. Howard? 15 MR. HOWARD: Yes, your Honor, and 16 Glenwood would respectfully move the admission into 17 evidence of Glenwood Exhibit 1. I understand that 18 the Bench may prefer to rule upon that motion at the 19 time the opinion and order is issued. Thank you. 20 EXAMINER SCHABO: The exhibits will all 21 be admitted as offered. 2.2 (EXHIBITS ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.) 23 EXAMINER SCHABO: Again, we will let the 24 Commission rule on the actual motion for waiver, but 25 we will admit the Glenwood Exhibit 1 into evidence.
