**{¶ 6}** In complaint proceedings before the Commission, the complainant has the burden of proving the allegations of the complaint. *Grossman v. Public Util. Comm.*, 5 Ohio St.2d 189, 214 N.E. 2d 666 (1966). Therefore, at hearing, it shall be Complainant's responsibility to appear and present evidence in support of the complaint.
