19 hearing to allow us to continue our efforts.

20 ATTORNEY EXAMINER: Very good.
21 Based on your statement I will continue the
22 matter. If necessary we can set it for hearing
23 again by subsequent entry.

24 So for the mean time I will consider
25 this matter on the record pending. Thank you
