

NOTICE OF PROPOSED MAJOR UTILITY FACILITY

NGO Transmission, Inc. (a subsidiary of The Energy Cooperative) proposes to improve the transmission system in the Heath area by upgrading and relocating an existing natural gas pipeline located in the Heath-Newark-Licking County Port Authority Industrial Park in the City of Heath. The purpose of the NGO Transmission Line 3-F Replacement Project (Project) is to replace aging, bare steel pipe over a distance of approximately one mile. The replaced pipeline will be located along existing roadway. The Project location and general layout are shown on the accompanying map.


NGO Transmission has filed a Letter of Notification to construct, operate, and maintain this facility with the Ohio Power Siting Board (Board), under Case No. 17-1994-GA-BLN.
