**MOTION OF SUMMIT ENERGY SERVICES, INC. FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
CONTINUE OPERATING**

On October 2, 2017, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio notified Summit Energy Services, Inc. (“Summit”) that its certification as an Aggregator has expired. Summit asks the Commission to grant to it a ninety (90) day extension of time of the certificate issued under Case No. 13-1175-GA-AGG (January 2, 2018). On October 20, 2017, Summit filed its new application for a Certificate.

Summit therefore asks the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio to grant this extension of time and permit it to continue operating under Certificate 1175 through January 2, 2018, or until the new certificate is granted.
