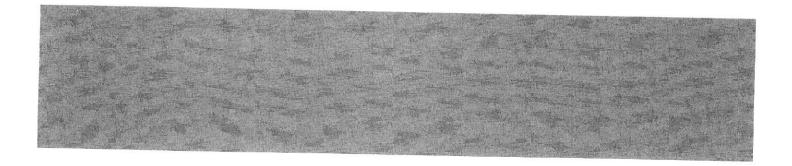
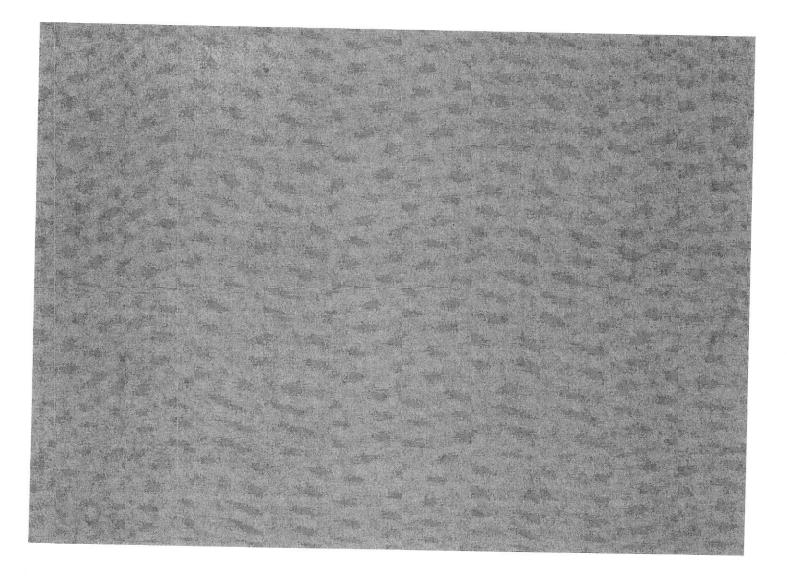


EXHIBIT B-1 JURISDICTIONS OF OPERATIONS



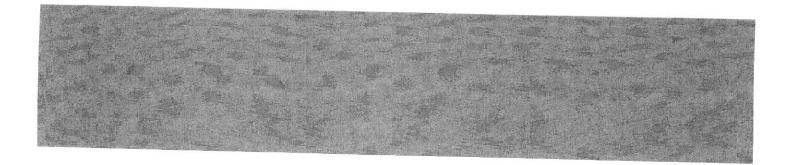


EXHIBIT B-2 EXPERIENCE AND PLANS

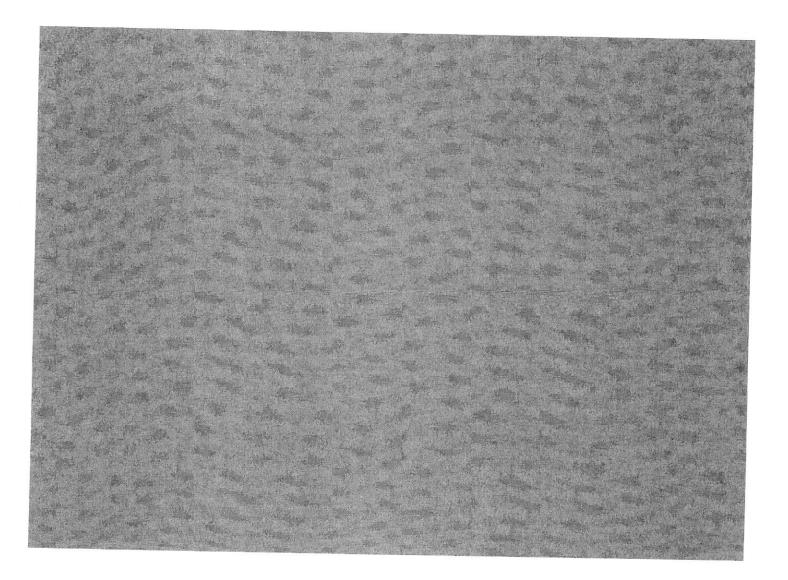

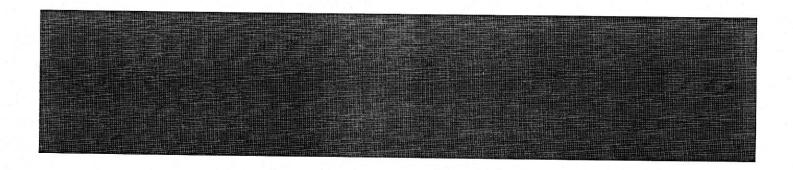
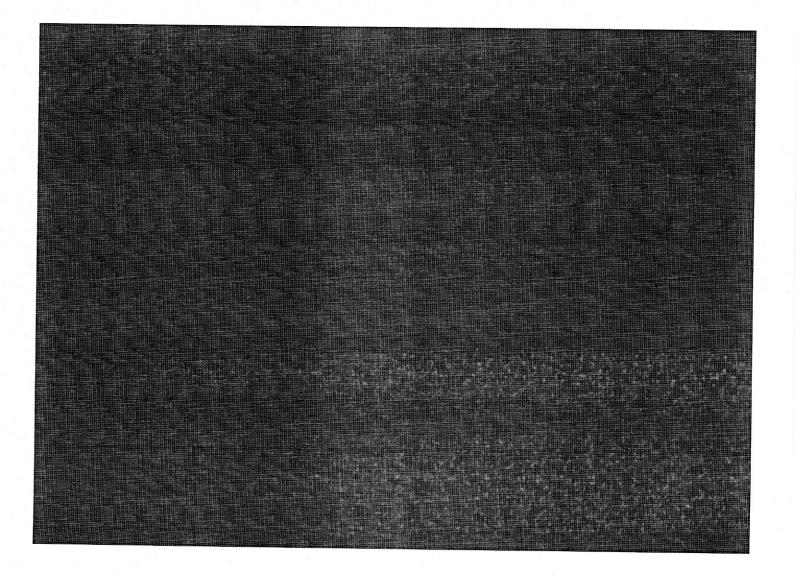


Exhibit C-6 "Credit Rating,"



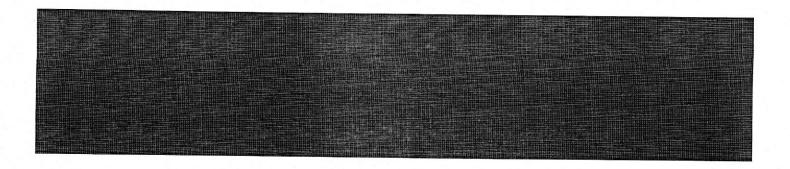
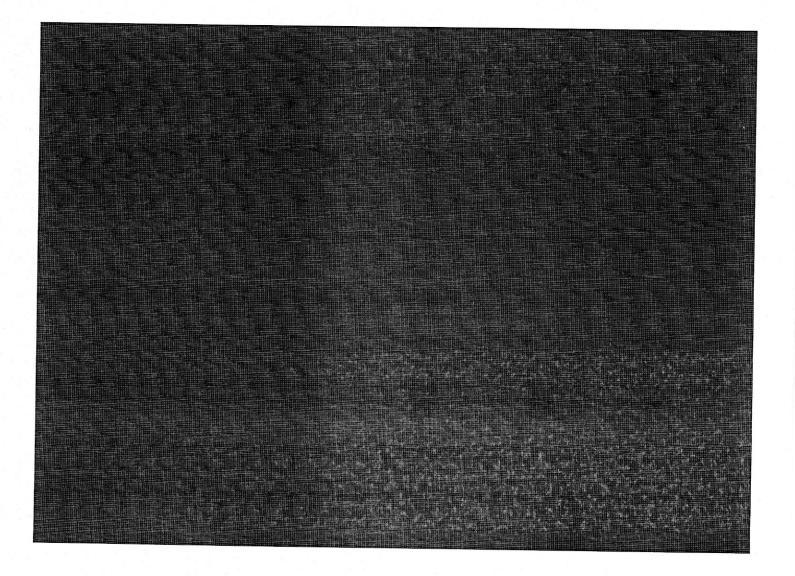


Exhibit C-7 "Credit Report,"

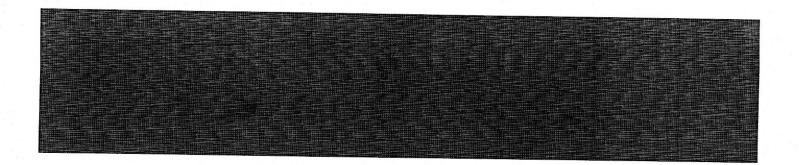


Exhibit C - 10 "Corporate Structure
