I wanted to comment on case number 17-1263-EL-SSO It seems ridiculous to me as a residential costumer that our fixed electric charges will increase by a magnitude of 4. I have solar panels on my house which cover the expense of my electric rates, but I still pay for he fixed costs. Increasing the fixed costs by 4 means that my solar panels will take almost 15 years to pay off instead of 8.... what is the motivation of this change? Duke had a profit of \$2.1 billion so it seems hard to justify this increase for all of us, specially for low income people, who already struggle to pay the bills... Duke also has \$30 fixed charge for gas already... so increasing it for electric means residential bills will always be \$50 even before adding the actual usage charges, which seems outrageous.
