{¶ 1} On September 11, 2017, an Entry was issued scheduling a November 15, 2017 hearing in the above-captioned cases.

{¶ 2} On November 3, 2017, counsel for SJA Transport, Inc. (SJA or Respondent) filed a motion for continuance. Counsel explains that he was recently retained to represent Respondent at hearing and had previously scheduled a vacation to take place just before the designated hearing date. Counsel asks that the hearing be rescheduled to December 13, 2017, at the earliest, and adds that Staff does not oppose a continuance.

{¶ 3} The attorney examiner finds reasonable SJA's motion for continuance. Therefore, the motion should be granted.

{¶ 4} In addition, the attorney examiner directs Respondent and Staff to collaborate and submit in the docket, no later than November 20, 2017, mutually agreed-upon dates for the hearing during the weeks of January 15 and 22, 2018, or later if necessary.

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the parties submit in the docket available new dates for the hearing, as directed in Paragraph 4. It is, further,
