Dear Honorable Patricia Schabo:

On November 1, 2017, the undersigned counsel for the Staff of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio filed a Settlement Agreement in the above-captioned case that was executed by the Respondent, Mr. Murton, and counsel for Staff (collectively, the "Parties"). The Parties recently discovered that they made an inadvertent error in the Settlement Agreement concerning their recommended total civil forfeiture of \$250.00 for the Group 0 and 2 violations. In this supplemental letter, the Parties want to correct the Settlement Agreement as to the amount the Parties had intended to recommend for the total civil forfeiture for the Group 0 and 2 violations. Accordingly, the Parties recommend that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio adopt \$150.00 as the total civil forfeiture to be paid by the Respondent for the Group 0 and 2 violations in the Settlement Agreement instead of \$250.00.
