I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission grants the Ohio Consumers' Counsel application for rehearing of the September 27, 2017 Opinion and Order for the purpose of further consideration of the matters specified in therein.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L or the Company), is an electric distribution utility as defined in R.C. 4928.01(A)(6) and a public utility as defined in R.C. 4905.02 and, as such, is subject to the energy efficiency and peak demand reduction (EE/PDR) requirements under R.C. 4928.64 and 4928.66. In this proceeding, the Commission reviewed DP&L's Energy Efficiency and Peak Demand Reduction Program Portfolio Plan for 2017 (Portfolio Plan), pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code Chapter 4901:1-39, to ensure that the Company's Portfolio Plan consists of cost-effective EE/PDR programs that achieve the statutory benchmarks for peak-demand reduction, and meet or exceed the statutory benchmarks for energy efficiency.

{¶ 3} On September 27, 2017, the Commission issued its Opinion and Order approving DP&L's Portfolio Plan, as modified by the Stipulation filed December 13, 2016, for 2017, and to continue thereafter until otherwise ordered by the Commission.

{¶ 4} On October 27, 2017, the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) filed an application for rehearing of the Opinion and Order. DP&L filed a memorandum in opposition on November 6, 2017.

{¶ 5} The Commission grants the OCC's application for rehearing as we find that sufficient reasons have been set forth to warrant further consideration of the matters specified therein.

III. ORDER

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the OCC's application for rehearing be granted for further consideration of the matters specified therein. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry on Rehearing be served upon each party of record.


