Dear Ms. McNeal:

The October 5, 2017, Opinion, Order, and Certificate ("Certificate") approving Guernsey Power Station, LLC ("GPS") Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need to Construct the Guernsey Power Station approved the Stipulation which set forth a set of conditions as part of the Certificate.

Within this set of conditions, Condition No. 20 requires that:

Applicant shall provide a copy of any floodplain permit required for construction of this project, or a copy of correspondence with the floodplain administrator showing that no permit is required, to Staff within seven days of issuance or receipt by the Applicant.

In compliance with **Condition No. 20**, attached is a copy of the December 6, 2017 letter from the Guernsey County Highway Department stating that major utility facilities permitted through the Ohio Power Siting do not require a Floodplain Development Permit. Thus, GPS is in compliance with Condition No. 20.

Per section 3.9 (C) of the Guernsey County Flood Development Regulations, major utility facilities that require permitting through the Ohio Power Siting Board are exempt from filing a Floodplain Development Permit. In this case, it applies to both the **POWER PLANT AND THE SUB-STATION**. Therefore, no application or subsequent permit from this office is required for your projects.
