**CAPITOL AREA ENERGY, INC.'S MOTION TO EXTEND ITS CERTIFICATE  
PENDING REVIEW OF NEW APPLICATION**

Capitol Area Energy, Inc.'s ("Capitol") certification as a Competitive Retail Electric Service Provider allowing it to provide aggregation/power broker services in Ohio expired on November 13, 2017. Pursuant to Ohio Adm Code § 4901:1-24-04, Capitol moves the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the "Commission") for a ruling that Capitol's previously issued Certificate as a Competitive Retail Electric Service Provider, Certificate No. 15-1024E(1), continue in effect and allow Capitol to continue operating uninterrupted until Capitol's new application for a certificate is approved by the Commission.

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**CAPITOL AREA ENERGY, INC.'S MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF  
ITS MOTION TO EXTEND ITS CERTIFICATE PENDING REVIEW OF  
NEW APPLICATION**

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (the “Commission”) initially issued Certificate No. 15-1024E (1), to Capitol Area Energy, Inc. (“Capitol”) on November 17, 2015 certifying Capitol as a Competitive Retail Service Provider (“CRES”) allowed to provide aggregation and power broker services in Ohio (the “Certificate”). A revised Certificate was issued on February 7, 2017. Capitol inadvertently missed its filing deadline to renew the Certificate, so the Certificate expired on November 13, 2017.

Pursuant to Ohio Adm Code § 4901:1-24-04, Capitol intends to file a new application for certification in a new proceeding imminently. To allow Capitol to continue providing services uninterrupted until approval of the new application, Capitol requests that the Commission issue an order extending the Certificate pending its review of Capitol’s new application. Capitol meets the requirements of Ohio Adm Code § 4901:1-24-04 because the Certificate expired less than sixty days from the date of this motion.

Accordingly, Capitol requests that the Commission extend its certificate while its new application is pending review.
