5.0 mi (8.0 km) of the Direct APE

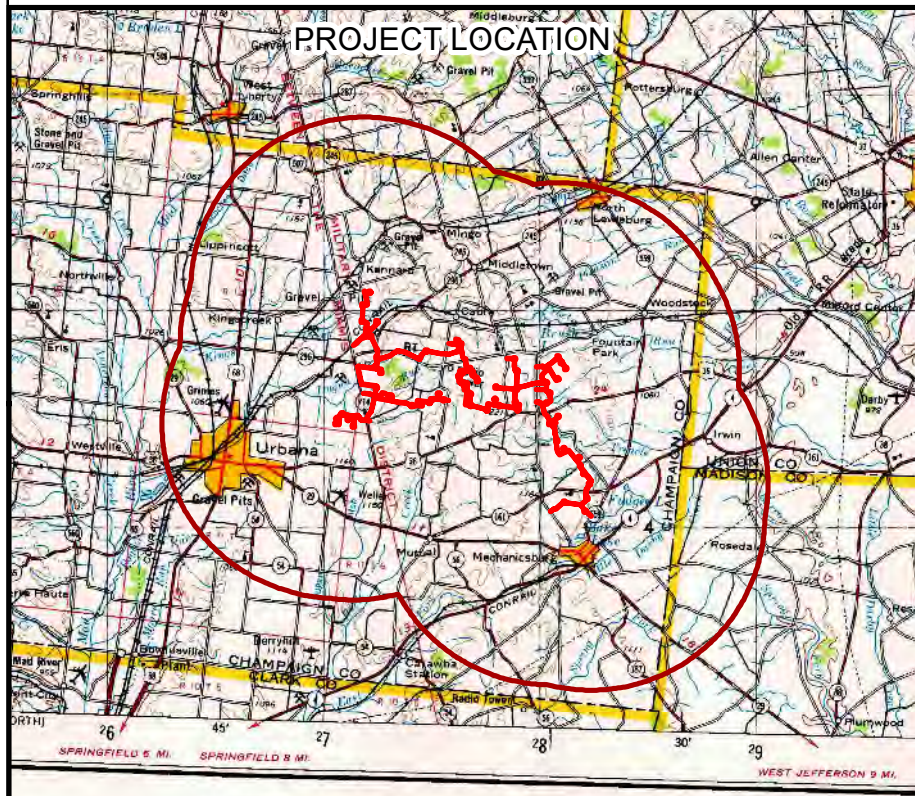

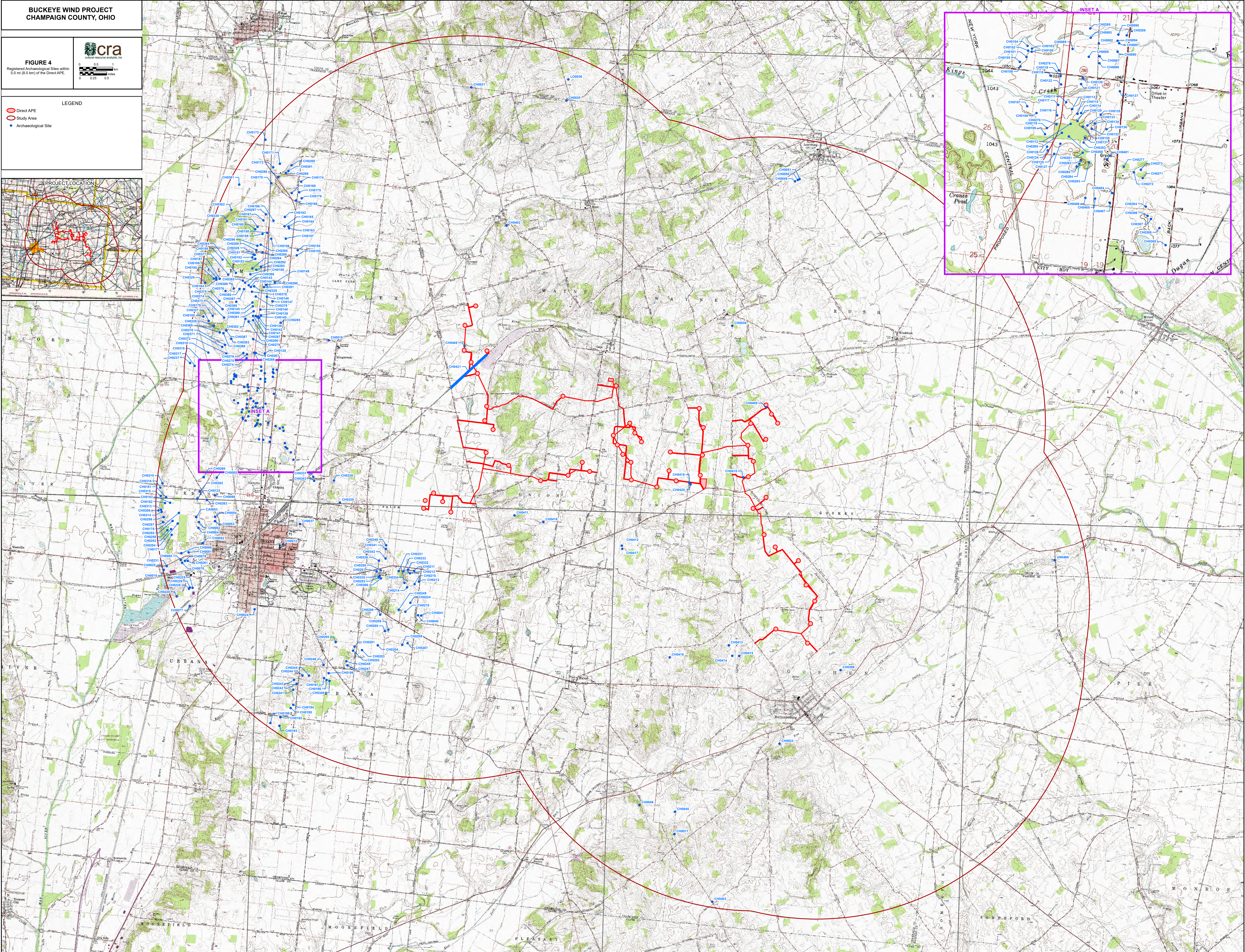

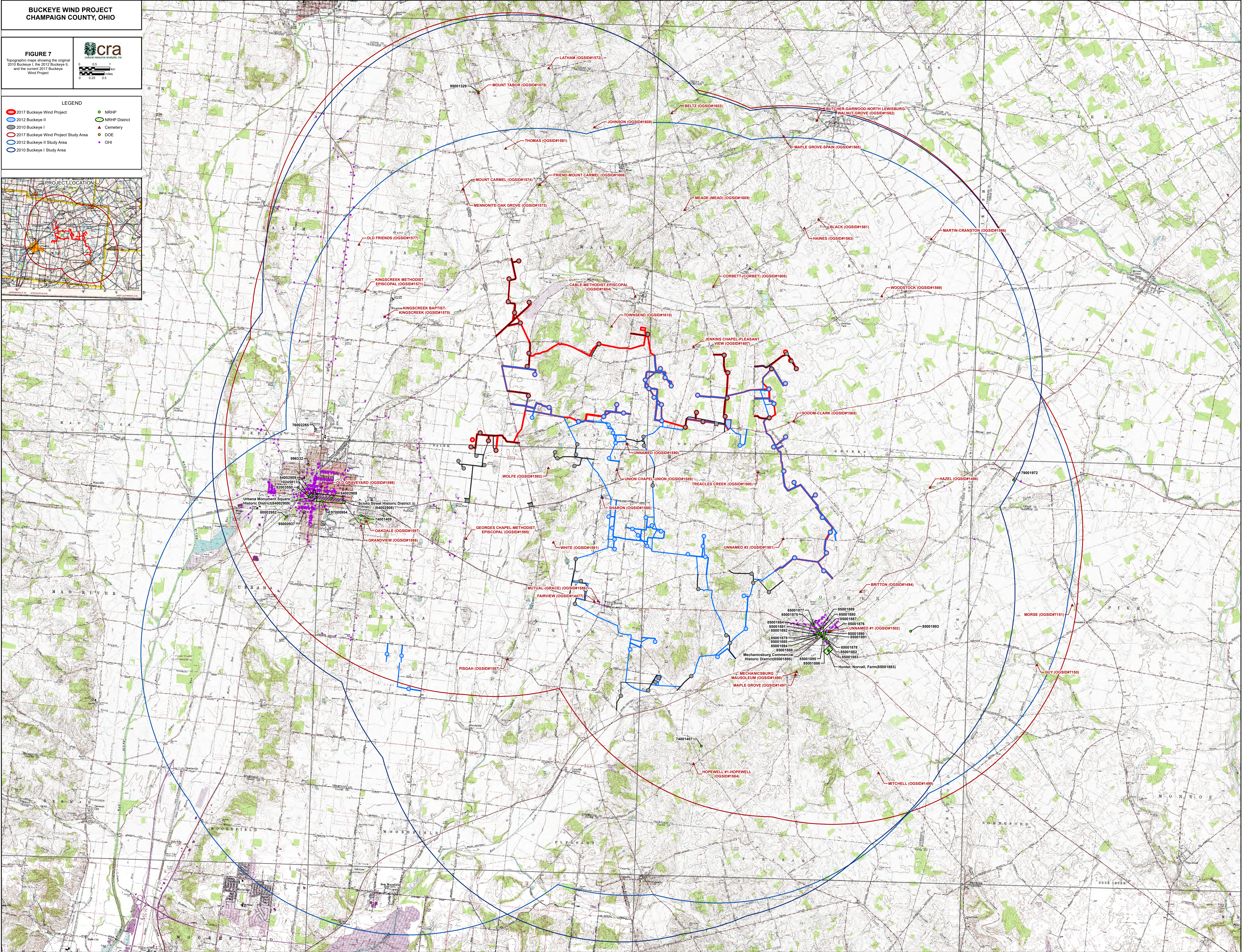
