SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY IN SUPPORT OF AT&T OHIO'S OPPOSITION TO OCC/EDGEMONT'S REQUEST FOR ABEYANCE

At the time AT&T Ohio filed its Memorandum Contra to the OCC request to hold this matter in abeyance, 12 of the 21 states in which AT&T operates as an ILEC had approved AT&T's ETC relinquishment.¹ In its Reply, the OCC argued that the 12 orders AT&T Ohio cited are "not germane to the situation here" because they "were issued *before* the FCC released its proposal to eliminate Lifeline support to telephone companies that are not facilities-based."² AT&T has already explained why the FCC's rulemaking should have no bearing on AT&T Ohio's ETC relinquishment. At this point, the FCC has done nothing more than offer a proposal – one which could remain pending for months, and which ultimately may be substantially modified or rejected. Unless and until there is an actual change in the rules, the PUCO remains obligated to adhere to existing law.³

Attached as supplemental authority for AT&T Ohio's position is a January 12, 2018 Order approving AT&T Texas' ETC relinquishment.⁴ That decision was issued well after the FCC issued its proposed rulemaking on December 1, 2017, and thus supports AT&T Ohio's

position that state commissions can and should proceed on pending ETC relinquishment requests by applying the law as it stands today.

This decision was not available to AT&T Ohio when it filed its Memorandum Contra on January 4, 2018, and therefore AT&T Ohio was unable to provide this authority to the Commission at that time.





PETITION OF AT&T TEXAS TO RELINQUISH ITS ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS CARRIER DESIGNATION IN SPECIFIED AREAS AND NOTICE OF TERMINATION OF ELIGIBLE TELECOMMUNICATIONS PROVIDER DESIGNATION



NOTICE OF APPROVAL

This Notice addresses the petition of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company d'ba AT&T Texas (AT&T Texas) to relinquish its (1) eligible telecommunications carrier (ETC) designation in certain portions of its exchange territory and (2) eligible telecommunications provider (ETP) designation in all of its incumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC) and competitive local exchange carrier (CLEC) service areas throughout Texas. Commission Staff filed an amended recommendation that the petition be granted. The petition is granted.

The Commission adopts the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

I. Findings of Fact

Procedural History

- On October 11, 2017, AT&T Texas notified the Commission that the company seeks to relinquish its ETC designation for certain portions of its exchange territory and relinquish its ETP designation in all of its service areas throughout Texas, including its ILEC and CLEC service areas under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 26.417(g) and 26.418(j)(1).
- The Commission designated AT&T Texas an ETC throughout its ILEC and CLEC services areas in Project No. 18100¹ for the purpose of receiving federal universal support.

Notice of Approval

- The Commission designated AT&T Texas as an ETP throughout its ILEC and CLEC service areas in Project No. 18769² for the purpose of receiving state universal support.
- 4. AT&T may relinquish its ETC and ETP designations in the areas described in this petition upon (a) providing written notice not less than 90 days prior to the proposed effective date that it seeks to relinquish its designation as an ETC and ETP; (b) determination by the Commission that the remaining ETCs and ETPs can offer federally supported services to the relinquishing carrier's customers; and (c) determination by the Commission that sufficient notice of relinquishment has been provided to permit the purchase or construction of adequate facilities by an remaining ETCs or ETPs.
- 5. Notice of petition was published in the Texas Register on October 27, 2017.
- 6. On November 3, 2017, Order No. 2 was issued deeming the application and notice sufficient and adopting a procedural schedule.
- On December 19, 2017, Commission Staff filed an amended recommendation that the petition be approved.

Petition

- 8. AT&T Texas requests relinquishment of its ETC designation in its entire CLEC service area and in its ILEC ETC service area with the exception of portions of certain wire centers containing census blocks for which it is eligible to receive Connect America Fund II funding.³
- 9. Provision of Lifeline service to AT&T Texas' customers will no longer be required as a result of relinquishment of it ETC and ETP designations. However, Lifeline customers in the affected areas will be notified by mail and bill insert message regarding AT&T Texas' intent to cease offering Lifeline service.

- 10. AT&T Texas meets the standard for relinquishing its ETC designation because each wire center in the relinquishment area has at least 10 other designated ETCS, and in some instances, as many as 19 other ETCs.
- 11. AT&T Texas' relinquishment of its ETP designation throughout its ILEC and CLEC ETP services area is consistent with the elimination of the statutory mandate and the concurrent relinquishment of its ETC status underlying its ETP status.⁴
- AT&T Texas proposes an effective date of June 26, 2018, for relinquishment of its ETC and ETP designations.
- 13. Because AT&T Texas will not cease providing service to its customers but is only relinquishing its ETC and ETP designations in the areas included in Attachments 1 and 2 to this Notice, there is no need for the remaining ETCs or ETPs to purchase or construct adequate facilities.

Informal Disposition

- 14. More than 15 days have passed since completion of the notice provided in this docket.
- 15. AT&T Texas and Commission Staff are the only parties to this proceeding.
- 16. No protests, motions to intervene, or requests for hearing were filed.
- 17. No issues of fact or law remain disputed by any party.

II. Conclusions of Law

- The Commission has jurisdiction over this docket under PURA §§ 52.001, 52.002, 55.004, and 56.023.
- The notice provided in this docket is sufficient under 16 TAC §§ 26.417(g)(1) and 26.418(j)(1) and 16 TAC § 22.55.
- 3. AT&T Texas has met the requirements to relinquish its ETC and ETP designations in the areas described in its application and this Notice under 16 TAC §§ 26.417(g)(1) and 26.418(j)(1).

4. The requirements for informal disposition in 16 TAC § 22.35 have been met in this proceeding.

III. Ordering Paragraphs

In accordance with these findings of fact and conclusions of law, the Commission issues the following orders:

- 1. AT&T Texas' petition is granted.
- 2. AT&T Texas' ETC and ETP designations are relinquished consistent with this Notice, effective June 26, 2018.
- 3. All other motions and any other requests for general or specific relief, if not expressly granted, are denied.
