- {¶ 1} On October 16, 2017, Larry Sturgill and Patricia Gilgenbach (Complainants) filed a complaint alleging that the Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council (NOPEC) changed their gas supplier without their knowledge. Complainants further allege that they have never received the required opt-out notices from NOPEC.
- {¶ 2} On December 1, 2017, the attorney examiner issued an Entry in this matter that scheduled a settlement conference for December 18, 2017.
- {¶ 3} As scheduled, a settlement conference was convened in this matter on December 18, 2017. An attorney examiner and counsel for NOPEC were present for the proceeding; however, neither of the Complainants attended the conference.
- {¶ 4} At this time, the attorney examiner finds that Complainants shall proceed utilizing one of two options: Complainants may (a) file a letter, by February 9, 2018, requesting either dismissal or continued action by the Commission on the complaint, or (b) take no action with regard to the complaint by the close of business on February 9, 2018, and the attorney examiner will recommend to the Commission that the case be dismissed.
