Memorandum in Support

Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc., (“Movant”) requests a thirty day extension of its Certificate No. 14-343G(2), which was issued by the Commission on February 16, 2016, bearing an expiration date of February 13, 2018. Pursuant to Ohio Admin. Code 4901:1-27-09(A), its renewal application was due to be filed no less than thirty days prior to the expiration date indicated on the its provider certificate, or January 12, 2018 (the actual 30-day date, January 14, 2018, was a weekend day followed by a state holiday – thus, in order to comply with the rule, the filing should have been filed on the previous Friday). Movant respectfully requests the additional time required to obtain assistance of counsel to ensure that the application, supporting exhibits and this motion for extension are filed in accordance with O.A.C. 4901:1-27-07(A), which requires assistance of an attorney authorized to practice law in the state of Ohio.

Rule 4901:1-27-09(B) provides in pertinent part: “Any renewal application filed fewer than thirty calendar days prior to the expiration date indicated on the certificate, but no later than the expiration date on the certificate, shall be filed with a motion requesting an extension of the certificate. If the motion is filed in conformance with rule 4901:1-27-07 of the Administrative Code, it shall be deemed automatically approved unless, within three business days of its filing, the commission or an attorney examiner appointed by the commission rules otherwise.”

Movant submits that no one will be prejudiced by the thirty day extension requested herein, and the additional time will permit Movant to complete the CRNG Broker renewal and extension process. Movant requests that the Commission consider

this motion to be filed with the Movant's CRNG Broker renewal application, submitted on January 16, 2018, to avoid the re-filing of the same document twice.

For the above reasons, Chrislynn Energy Services, Inc., respectfully moves that its Certificate No. 114-343G(2) be extended automatically for thirty days as permitted in Rule 4901:1-27-09(B).
