1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Introduction

Republic Wind, LLC (hereafter referred to as the “Applicant”) is proposing to construct the Republic Wind Farm (hereafter referred to as the “Facility”) in rural Sandusky and Seneca Counties. The Applicant is currently in the process of preparing an Application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need (the Application), prepared in compliance with Section 4906.06 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapters 4906-4-01 through 4906-4-08 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

On behalf of the Applicant, EDR prepared the following cultural resources records review in support of environmental review and permitting for the proposed Facility. This cultural resources records review has been prepared by a Registered Professional Archaeologist (RPA) and a qualified architectural historian who meets the U.S. Secretary of Interior’s Standards for Historic Preservation Projects (36 CFR Part 61). The cultural resources records review and impact assessment is designed to satisfy the requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4906-04-08(D)(1) and (2) for the OPSB which requires that all cultural resources be evaluated within 5-miles (8.1 kilometers [km]) of the Facility.

1.2 Project Location and Description

The Project Area is defined as an area encompassing all Facility-related development and consists of approximately 35,000 acres of private land in Adams, Pleasant, Reed, Scipio, and Thompson Townships (Seneca County) and Green Creek and York Townships (Sandusky County; Figure 1). The Facility presented herein consists of up to 58 wind turbine generators, each with a nameplate capacity rating of 3.3 to 3.63 megawatts (MW), depending on the final turbine model selected. In addition to the turbines, the Facility will include up to approximately 23 miles (37 kilometers [km]) of access roads, up to approximately 84 miles (135.2 km) of buried 34.5 kV electrical collection cable, a collection substation, a temporary laydown yard for construction staging, an O&M building, and up to two permanent meteorological towers. Additional information about each Facility component is presented in Table 1. A detailed description of the Facility, including each Facility component, can be found in Section 4906-4-03(B) of the Application.

¹ These areas represent averages for clearing and soil disturbance. Some sections of buried electrical cable may be wider than 20 feet because of the number of collection circuits that need to convene near the collection substation. However, in many other locations the disturbance may be less than 20 feet, resulting in an overall average of 20 feet across the Project Area.

² As described below in Section 4906-4-03(B)(2)(j), the Facility will require a temporary laydown yard for construction staging. This Application seeks approval for three laydown yard sites; however, only one laydown yard will ultimately be constructed. The laydown yard will not exceed 12 acres in size.

³ As described below in Section 4906-4-03(B)(2)(h), the Facility will require up to two permanent meteorological towers. This Application seeks approval for six meteorological tower sites; however, only two will ultimately be constructed. While the impact assumptions in Table 1 are per tower, all impacts presented in this Application account for two meteorological towers.

2.0 RECORDS REVIEW AND IMPACT ASSESSMENT

2.1 Methodology

Per the requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4906-04-08(D), the cultural resources records review was completed for the area within a 5-mile (8.1-km) radius of the Project Area (“the Study Area”; Figure 2) and includes the following records available from the Ohio State Historic Preservation Office (OHPO):

- Ohio Historic Preservation Office (OHPO) previous Phase I, II, and III cultural resources surveys
- National Register of Historic Places (NRHP)
- NRHP Determination of Eligibility (DOE) properties
- National Historic Landmarks (NHL) List
- Ohio Historic Inventory (OHI)
- Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT)
- Historic Bridge Inventory
- Ohio Archaeological Inventory (OAI)
- Ohio Genealogical Society (OGS) cemetery files
- Mills *Archaeological Atlas of Ohio* (1914)

2.2 Cultural Resources Records Review

Archives and repositories consulted during EDR’s research for the Project included the online Geographic Information Systems (GIS) mapping system of the OHPO, the David Rumsey map collection, Ancestry.com and other online history resources, and EDR’s in-house collection of reference materials. The results of the cultural resources records review for the Study Area associated with the Facility are described below and depicted on Figures 3 and 4.

2.2.1 Previous Cultural Resources Surveys

2.2.1.1 Archaeological Surveys

Per the OHPO GIS mapping system, 43 Phase I archaeological surveys and four Phase II archaeological investigations have been completed within the Study Area; however, all were located outside the Project Area for the proposed Facility (Figure 5, Appendix A). The Phase I archaeological surveys were completed for 12 (28%) communications towers, six (14%) industrial development projects, six (14%) municipal development projects, four (9%) residential developments, three (7%) bridge replacements, three (7%) water pipelines, two (5%) gas pipelines, two (5%) transmission lines, one (2%) transportation/roads project, one (2%) railroad project, one (2%) hospital, one (2%) airport, and one (2%) water tower. Two of the Phase II investigations were completed at pre-contact sites and two were completed at multi-component pre-contact and historic-period sites.

2.2.1.2 Historic Architectural Surveys

One historic architectural resources survey (Figure 5), has been completed within the Study Area, and is summarized below. This survey is located outside the Project Area for the proposed Facility (Figure 5). Additionally, a cultural resources records review and a historic architectural resources windshield survey were completed, but never submitted to OHPO, for a previous iteration of the Republic Wind Farm. All three previous studies are discussed below.

In 2002, a historic resources survey was completed by the Mannik & Smith Group (MSG) within a 0.5-mile buffer around the proposed Bellevue Grade Separation Site (OHPO Survey ID H00220), located northeast of the Project Area, but within the Study Area, in Bellevue, Ohio (MSG, 2002). No NRHP-listed properties were identified within the Bellevue Grade Separation Study Area. However, forty-nine previously recorded OHI sites (pre-1952) were identified within the Bellevue Grade Separation Study Area, with one located in the Bellevue Grade Separation Project Area. Through a reconnaissance survey completed in November and December of 2001, an additional 25 resources older than 50 years were identified. Of those 25 resources, three retained a high degree of integrity and were listed in the OHI (MSG, 2002).

In 2012, the Hardlines Design Company of Columbus (HDC), on behalf of BHE Environmental, Inc. (BHE) of Cincinnati, completed a cultural resources records review for an earlier version of the Republic Wind Project which involved 60-80 turbines over 47 square miles (HDC 2012). This layout had similar, but not identical, Project and 5-mile Study Area boundaries to the currently proposed Facility and identified 363 previously surveyed buildings with OHPO resource forms, 30 within the footprint of the Project. Using HDC's report as a foundation, BHE subsequently completed a Phase IA 5-mile architectural windshield survey, identifying nine NRHP-eligible or -listed properties (BHE 2012). Neither the HDC, nor the BHE reports, were submitted to OHPO.

There were two discrepancies between the 2002 MSG study and the 2012 BHE study when compared to current data on the OHPO GIS website. Per the MSG (2002) report, the property at 210 Kilbourne Street in Bellevue was previously recorded as SAN0000512. However, it is now known as resource SAN0037912, which has been updated in Appendix D. In the BHE (2012) report, the William Baker House (resource SEN0099805) was indicated as listed on, or eligible for, the NRHP. The OHPO GIS database indicated that it had not been listed, nor evaluated. Communication with OHPO clarified that formal evaluation of that property had not taken place.¹

2.2.2 National Register of Historic Places (NRHP)

The records review of the OHPO online GIS mapping system identified 11 NRHP-listed properties have been recorded within the Study Area, two of which are located within the Project Area. They are included as Appendix B.

2.2.3 NRHP Determination of Eligibility (DOE) properties

The records review of the OHPO online GIS mapping system identified four properties previously determined eligible for the NRHP have been recorded within the Study Area, none of which are located within the Project Area. They are included as Appendix C.

2.2.4 National Historic Landmarks (NHL)

No designated National Historic Landmarks are located within the Study Area.

2.2.5 Ohio Historic Inventory (OHI)

The records review of the OHPO online GIS mapping system identified 390 OHI properties have been recorded within the Study Area, 47 of which are located within the Project Area. They are included as Appendix D.

2.2.6 Historic Bridge Inventory

The records review of the ODOT GIS mapping system identified two historic bridges as listed on the Ohio Historic Bridge Inventory within the Study Area:

- Bridge Number 74001618 (located 4.1 miles [6.6 km] northwest of the Project Area) is the Mull Road Covered Bridge over the East Branch Wolf Creek in Sandusky County, which is a wooden Town's lattice through truss-type bridge, constructed in 1851 that is listed on the NRHP.
- Bridge Number 7450192 (located on the border of the Project Area) is the Township Road 80 bridge over Royer Ditch in Thompson Township, Seneca County, which is a reinforced concrete slab type bridge that is eligible for listing on the NRHP.

2.2.7 Ohio Archaeological Inventory (OAI)

The records review of the OHPO online GIS mapping identified 698 OAI properties have been recorded within the Study Area, 95 of which are located within the Project Area. They are included as Appendix E.

2.2.8 Ohio Genealogical Society (OGS) files

The records review of the OHPO online GIS mapping identified 65 OGS cemeteries have been recorded within the Study Area, nine of which are located within the Project Area. They are included as Appendix F.

2.2.9 *Mills Archaeological Atlas of Ohio (1914)*

A review of the 1914 *Mills Archaeological Atlas of Ohio* (see Figure 4) indicates the following for the four counties contained within Study Area:

- **Erie County:** According to Mills (1914), the primary pre-contact habitation in Erie County focused along the lakeshore of Erie County. The Study Area only occupies the very southwestern corner of Erie County and the Project Area does not occur in Erie County at all. Mills (1914:22) does not depict any archaeological sites within Study Area.
- **Huron County:** According to Mills (1914), the most significant pre-contact earthworks in Huron County occur near the City of Norwalk, well outside the Study Area. Mills (1914:39) does not depict any archaeological sites within the Study Area, and the Project Area does not occur in Huron County at all.
- **Sandusky County:** According to Mills (1914), Sandusky County was significant during the pre-contact period because several major trails came together near the south shore of Sandusky Bay. However, Mills (1914:72) also notes there were: “a number of enclosures and other works found along the Sandusky river”. One enclosure was located where the City of Fremont now stands, while between that City and the bay there were at least five others. One was located immediately south of Fremont and another near the south line of the county...” Mills (1914:72) depicts two archaeological sites within the Study Area; however, neither is within the Project Area itself.
- **Seneca County:** Mills (1914:74) notes a moderate density of pre-contact archaeological sites within Seneca County, including a dense area of prehistoric habitation in Thompson Township in the northeastern corner of the county (partially within the Project Area). Additionally, the “old Scioto Trail” followed the Sandusky River through the central portion of the county (within the western edge of the Study Area) to its termination at Sandusky Bay to the north. According to Mills (1914:74), 12 archaeological sites occur within the Study Area: five village sites, four burial sites, one burial mound, one stone grave and one cemetery. Two of the village sites and one burial site occur within the Project Area. The two village sites are depicted in the vicinity of proposed Facility components and may be located within the Facility footprint.

In summary, Mills (1914) depicts a total of 14 pre-contact archaeological sites within the 5-mile Study Area (two in Sandusky County and 12 in Seneca County), and a total of three archaeological sites within the Project Area. The two village sites depicted within the Project Area may occur within the current Facility footprint; however, the Mills (1914) maps are not sufficiently detailed to precisely identify the exact locations of the resources depicted. It is notable that significantly more archaeological sites described by Mills (1914) occur within the Study Area than within the Project Area. This is in part due to the large size of the Study Area; however, the paucity of previously recorded pre-contact archaeological sites also may be attributable to the lack of major rivers within the Project Area. The Project is located


on a relatively level plain between the Sandusky River to the west and the Huron River to the east and contains only a few small creeks within its boundaries.

2.2.10 Historic Map Review

Historic maps reviewed for the Project Area (excluding the Study Area) included the 1872 Gray, Lloyd and Walling *Topographical Atlas of Cuyahoga, Erie, Huron, Lorain, Medina, Ottawa, Sandusky, Seneca, and Summit Counties, Ohio* (Figure 6), the 1891 Hughes *Atlas and Map of Sandusky County* and 1896 Woods *Map of Seneca County* (Figure 7), the 1914 Mills *Archaeological Atlas of Ohio* (Figure 4), and the USGS 1959 *Bellevue*, 1960 *Clyde*, 1960 *Fireside*, 1960 *Flat Rock*, 1958 *Fremont East*, 1960 *Tiffin North*, and 1960 *Watson, Ohio* 7.5 minute topographic quadrangles (Figure 8).

An excerpt from the 1872 Gray, Lloyd and Walling *Topographical Atlas of Cuyahoga, Erie, Huron, Lorain, Medina, Ottawa, Sandusky, Seneca, and Summit Counties, Ohio* (Figure 6) depicts the Project Area within Adams, Pleasant, Reed, Scipio, and Thompson Townships in Seneca County, and Green Creek and York Townships in Sandusky County. Lots are separated into approximate 1-mile grids, with orthogonal roadways along most of those boundaries. Diagonal thoroughfares cross through the grid, connecting the central portion of Seneca County to Bellevue, as depicted in the 1888 Burleigh and Norris *Birdseye View of Bellevue, Ohio* (Burleigh Lithograph Co, 1888; Inset 1) in southwest Sandusky County, within the Cultural Resources Study Area. Though generally the Atlas does not depict structures, a handful of buildings in the villages of West Lodi, Flat Rock, Watsons Station and Adams (present-day Lowell) were drawn, suggesting that by 1872 they were burgeoning settlements in an agricultural landscape.

The 1896 Woods *Map of Seneca County* and 1891 Hughes *Atlas and Map of Sandusky County* (Figure 7) show the extent to which the 1-mile grid had been further subdivided into five-to-ten individual plots, presumably for farming. These parcels are labeled by landowner, although no structures are depicted. By 1891, additional streets on a smaller grid were laid in the present-day villages of Flat Rock and West Lodi putting them ahead of Watson Station and Adams (present-day Lowell) in terms of density, population and therefore architectural resources.

The 1880s brought the Nickel Plate, Wheeling and Lake Erie railroads into northern Ohio, adding several thousand people to the population of Bellevue in southeast Sandusky County, transforming it from a rural village into a small town. (Burleigh Lithograph Co, 1888; Library of Congress website)

The 1914 Mills *Archaeological Atlas of Ohio* (Figure 4) was also reviewed during background research for the current Project, and prehistoric archaeological sites depicted in the atlas were discussed in Section 2.2.9 of this report. In addition to archaeological sites, the Mills Atlas also depicts the state of development throughout Ohio in 1914. Relative to the earlier Woods (1896) and Hughes (1891) maps of Seneca and Sandusky Counties, the Mills (1914) maps show a similar pattern of development in the Project Area, albeit at a decreased level of detail, with the landscape divided into 1-mile sections and major roads radiating out from population centers. West Lodi and Flat Rock continued to serve in their roles as commercial centers in northeast Seneca County. Roads in the 1914 Atlas are approximately in their modern alignment.

The USGS 1959 *Bellevue*, 1960 *Clyde*, 1960 *Fireside*, 1960 *Flat Rock*, 1958 *Fremont East*, 1960 *Tiffin North*, and 1960 *Watson, Ohio* 1:24,000 (7.5 minute) topographic quadrangles (Figure 8) show similar conditions to the 1914 Mills Atlas, with additional map-documented structures within the Cultural Resources Study Area. Rural development remains sparse and spaced out along state, county and local roads, concentrated at their intersections. The mid-twentieth century USGS maps depict similar patterns of the development to the present day.

2.3 Impact Assessment

Per the requirements of 4906-4-08(D)(2) of the Ohio Administrative Code, EDR assessed the potential impact(s) to the preservation and continued meaningfulness posed by construction and operation of the proposed Project. It was

determined that there will be no direct impacts to aboveground cultural resources (i.e., cemeteries or historic structures) within the Project Area from construction or operation of the proposed Facility, and no specific mitigation measures are proposed at this time. However, the impacts to previously recorded and hereto unidentified archaeological resources are currently unknown.

The proposed Project has the potential to cause indirect (visual) impacts to aboveground historic and recreational resources within the Study Area. However, the rural nature and low population density of the area, as well as the general lack of major thoroughfares, limits the number of viewers potentially affected by the proposed Facility. A complete visual impacts analysis has been completed for the proposed Facility in accordance with Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4906-04-08(D)(4).

3.0 CONCLUSION

EDR prepared this cultural resources records review in support of environmental review and permitting for the proposed Republic Wind Farm. This report is designed to satisfy the requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4906-04-08(D)(1) and (2) for the OPSB which requires that all cultural resources be evaluated within 5-miles (8.1 km) of the Facility.












