**REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION  
SUBMITTED ON BEHALF OF THE STAFF OF  
THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO**

Pursuant to §4901:1-6-14(F)(2) of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), a for-profit incumbent local exchange carrier (ILEC) shall maintain a tariffed rate cap for BLES and shall file an updated tariff, for each exchange with BLES flexibility, at the end of each twelve-month period, to reflect the new anniversary date and, as necessary, the new tariffed rate cap for BLES. This section further states such tariff amendment shall be filed as a zero-day tariff amendment (ZTA).

On January 4, 2018, AT&T Ohio (Applicant) filed a zero-day notice filing to revise its P.U.C.O. No. 20 tariff to update the basic local exchange service (BLES) pricing flexibility information to reflect the new anniversary date and the new tariffed rate cap for BLES. The Staff reviewed all documents and exhibits submitted with this filing and finds that the Applicant's filing satisfies all requirements the set forth in §4901:1-6-14(F)(2).

In conclusion, Staff recommends that this filing be permitted to remain in effect.
