Dear Examiners:

On December 21, 2016, the Signatory Parties filed a Joint Stipulation and Recommendation involving all of the above-captioned cases (Global Settlement).

On February 23, 2017, the Commission issued an Order adopting the Global Settlement. Among other terms and conditions of the Global Settlement, the Company implemented the SEET Credit Rider over twelve months to return \$20.3 million to customers. The SEET Credit Rider will expire effective with the first billing cycle of April 2018, because it has run for the prescribed twelve-month period and it would take less than one-month billing cycle to credit the remaining balance. The Company will update its tariffs accordingly. As to the remaining balance, the Company recommends that it be added to the undistributed FAC Refund balance which, consistent with the terms of the Global Settlement, remains available for use as determined by the Commission. In any case, the Company will await further direction from the Commission as to the remaining balance for the SEET Credit Rider and the FAC Refund.
