I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission finds that Certificate No. 11-SPV-OH-GATS-1391 should be revoked, and this case should be dismissed and closed of record.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} On April 8, 2011, Sol Systems, LLC, on behalf of Gary Krisher (Applicant), filed an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility. The name of the facility is Krisher-Gary-OH-PV-2.55KW Residence, located at 5439 Townsend Road, Athens, OH, 45701(Facility). According to the application, the Facility is a 2.55 kilowatt solar photovoltaic system.

{¶ 3} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F)(2) provides for automatic approval of an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, unless the Commission suspends the application within sixty days. On June 8, 2011, Applicant received automatic approval and a certificate was issued and assigned Certificate No. 11-SPV-OH-GATS-1391.

{¶ 4} On June 10, 2016, Staff filed its review and recommendation of the application. In its report, Staff states that, it observed that the facility certified in this proceeding appeared to be a duplicate of the facility certified in Case No. 11-1098-EL-REN (*See* Staff's Review and Recommendation). 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Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), and the facility was certified with an effective date of May 4, 2011, and assigned Certificate No. 11-SPV-OH-GATS-1077. On April 30, 2014, Sol Systems, LLC, confirmed the duplication of facilities by filing a letter in each proceeding. Staff further notes that the facility recognized in Case No. 11-1098-EL-REN is registered on PJM EIS' Generation Attributes Tracking System (GATS), and the facility certified in Case No. 11-1925-EL-REN is not registered under GATS.

{¶ 5} The Commission finds that, because the facility certified in Case No. 11-1925-EL-REN is a duplicate of the facility certified in Case No. 11-1098-EL-REN and is not currently registered with GATS, it is reasonable to revoke Certificate No. 11-SPV-OH-GATS-1391 issued in Case No. 11-1925-EL-REN, as recommended by Staff.

III. ORDER

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That Certificate No. 11-SPV-OH-GATS-1391 be revoked. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That Case No. 11-1925-EL-REN be dismissed and closed of record.It is, further,
