### I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission finds the request to rescind the certification for the Wilshinsky Residence - S. Wilshinsky facility is reasonable and should be granted.

### II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} On June 10, 2011, Sigrid Wilshinsky (Applicant) filed an application for certification of a rooftop solar photovoltaic system located on a residence in Newfoundland, Pennsylvania, as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, as defined by R.C. 4928.01(A)(37). On August 17, 2011, Certificate No. 11-SPV-PA-GATS-1850 was issued pursuant to the 60-day automatic approval process, with an effective date of August 10, 2011.

{¶ 3} On January 9, 2018, SRECTrade, Inc., on behalf of Applicant, filed a notification indicating that the solar system had been decommissioned and requested that the facility's certificate be deactivated as it would no longer be generating electricity.

{¶ 4} The Commission finds the request to decertify the facility is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, we find that Certificate No. 11-SPV-PA-GATS-1850 should be rescinded and this case be dismissed and closed of record.


### III. ORDER

{¶ 5} It is, therefore,




