I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission finds the request to decertify the McCormick Motors SolarPV facility is reasonable and should be granted.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} On November 29, 2010, McCormick Motors (Applicant) filed an application for certification of a rooftop solar photovoltaic system located in Nappanee, Indiana, as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, as defined by R.C 4928.01(A)(37). On January 28, 2011, Certificate No. 11-SPV-IN-GATS-0217 was issued pursuant to the 60-day automatic approval process, with an effective date of January 29, 2011. The Commission was notified of two expansions to the facility on March 4, 2011, and May 31, 2016, increasing the overall capacity to 64.85 kilowatts.

{¶ 3} On February 1, 2018, SRECTrade, Inc., on behalf of the Applicant, notified the Commission of a change in ownership of the facility and requested the Commission decertify the expansions to the facility. SRECTrade, Inc. amended the request on February 14, 2018 and requested the Commission decertify the entire facility.

{¶ 4} The Commission finds the request to decertify the facility is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, we find that Certificate No. 11-SPV-IN-GATS-0217 should be rescinded and this case be dismissed and closed of record.
