The enrollments are then transmitted electronically to the suppliers governing the plans. PS notifies clients 30 days before their contract expiration so they can re-evaluate their options and not get exposed to higher variable rates. PS brokers both residential and commercial energy plans, and currently operates in all electricity and natural gas (if applicable) zones in New York, Connecticut and New Jersey.
