I. SUMMARY

{¶ 1} The Commission finds that the application of Charles Stopp for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility should be withdrawn, and this case should be dismissed and closed of record.

II. DISCUSSION

{¶ 2} On June 27, 2017, Sol Systems LLC, on behalf of Charles Stopp (Applicant), filed an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility. The name of the facility is Stopp-Charles-PA-PV-14.16kw Residence (Facility), located at 1939 Wynonah Drive, Auburn, Pennsylvania 17922. According to the application, the facility is a solar photovoltaic electricity generator.

{¶ 3} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F)(2) provides for automatic approval of an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, unless the Commission suspends the application within sixty days.

{¶ 4} On August 2, 2017, the Applicant filed a request to withdraw the application for a renewable energy facility.

{¶ 5} The Commission finds that the request by the Applicant to withdraw its application for a renewable energy facility is reasonable and should be granted.

III. ORDER

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the request by Charles Stopp to withdraw his application for a renewable energy facility be granted. It is, further,


{¶ 8} ORDERED, That Case No. 17-1505-EL-REN be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,

{¶ 9} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of the record.






