

Summary

On April 25, 2018, the Commission issued its Opinion and Order (O&O) in Case No. 16-1852-EL-SSO and 16-1853-EL-AAM. In the O&O, Ohio Power Company (Company) was ordered to file proposed tariffs, consistent the O&O, for review and approval by the Commission.

On May 4, 2018, the Company filed its compliance tariffs to reflect the Commission's O&O. On May 8, 2018, the Company filed additional compliance tariffs to correct typographical or formatting errors as well as include rider schedules where additional reconciliation language was ordered by the Commission, but omitted in the May 4, 2018, compliance filing.

Staff Review and Recommendations

Staff has reviewed the compliance tariffs as filed on May 4, 2018 and May 8, 2018 and believes the tariffs comply with the Commission's O&O.

Conclusion

The Staff recommends that the compliance tariffs filed on May 4, and May 8, 2018, be approved, and that the tariffs become effective on the first billing cycle of June, 2018.
