The blasting plan will address blasting times, blasting signs, warnings, access control, control of adverse effects, and blast records.</p> <p>(c) A plan for liability protection and complaint resolution.</p>	<i>Completed</i>
25	<p>The Applicant shall avoid construction in upland sandpiper preferred nesting habitat types during the species' nesting period of April 15 to July 31.</p>	<i>Completed</i>
27	<p>The Applicant shall adhere to seasonal cutting dates of October 1 and March 31 for removal of suitable Indiana bat and Northern long-eared bats habitat trees.</p> <p>If tree clearing must occur outside of these dates, the Applicant shall coordinate with the ODNR, the USFWS, and Staff for further recommendations to avoid or minimize impacts to these species.</p>	<i>Completed</i>
