{¶ 1} On May 4, 2018, North American Power & Gas, LLC (NAPG) filed an application for renewal of its certification as a competitive retail natural gas service (CRNGS) marketer.

{¶ 2} In accordance with R.C. 4929.20 and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-27-10, NAPG's application for certification renewal is subject to a 30-day automatic approval process. Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-27-10 further provides that, upon good cause shown, the Commission or an attorney examiner may suspend consideration of an application for certification renewal. If an application for certification renewal is suspended, the Commission shall act to approve or deny the application within 90 days of the suspension.

{¶ 3} The attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 30-day automatic approval process with respect to NAPG's application for certification renewal, in order that the Commission and Staff may review the matter further.

{¶ 4} It is, therefore,

{¶ 5} ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for NAPG's application for certification renewal as a CRNGS marketer be suspended. It is, further,

{¶ 6} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon each party of record.
