MS. DI KRIVCHENIA: First I want to say that last Friday at 2:00 P.M. there was a meeting at my home with Joe Alman. He was very clear about everything that was happening.

He promised me that there would be no BS, and that he knew more about the project than anybody, so he could tell us.

So I asked him if I could call my neighbors over so that they would actually know what was going on whether they were owners or they lived within the thousand foot space.

I think before that time I was not clear on information. And I do need to say that partially that was me thinking there was going to be single poles as opposed to H frames. I only found out about H frames less than three weeks ago. The day after the holiday.

Once I knew it was going to H frames
I popped into gear and tried to find out every
piece of information I could, and I could not
find the H frames for this project on the AEP
website at that time. I feel that we got
the letters before AEP updated their website.

But, when Joe came to my home he showed us everything that was going to be

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happening, told us what we could do about it, which is nothing. And I feel like I came a little late to the party, because I did.

While I have never hired an attorney in my life, except to do wills and trust things, I felt really unknowledgeable about how to go about it. And I feel that from the last hearing we had in Marietta people were unclear about what was happening. I felt that not enough effort was made to be transparent and honest with people.

And, of course, my neighbors, most of them knew nothing about this. And my next-door neighbor is an attorney who knew about the extended part, but didn't know it was going to come across that close to her property.

I think Joe determined she is actually 498 feet away, and he should have contacted her, but he didn't.

So, of course, my neighbors are very upset. This is coming through my property, but just a small part of my property. It is on the edge of my property.

And while I would like the alternative plan a lot better, I am more

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     concerned that it's going through a

- Q. Good morning, Mr. Howard. You have before you what's been marked AEP Ohio Transco

  Exhibit 7; correct?
  - A. Correct. Yes, I do.
- 10 Q. What is this document?
- A. It is the direct testimony of Ronald
  M. Howard, Jr. on behalf of AEP in the matter of

- Q. Thank you. Was this testimony prepared by you or under your direction?

- Q. And do you have any corrections or additions at this time?

17 By Mr. Margard:

- Q. Good morning, Mr. Howard.
- 19 A. Good morning.
  - Q. You have been involved in a number of these cases; haven't you?
  - A. Yes, I have.
- Q. And you have been involved in
  discussions that have resulted in
  the stipulations just like this one; haven't

you?

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- 2 A. Yes, I have.
  - Q. In your experience do you believe that this stipulation was arrived at by discussions among knowledgeable parties?
  - A. I do.
- 7 Q. And experienced parties in such 8 matters?
  - A. Yes, I do.
- Q. Mr. Howard, do you believe that
  the stipulation that has been offered today is
  in the public interest?
  - A. I do.
  - Q. And how do you believe that it benefits the public, sir?
- 16 Over the last approximately three 17 years AEP has been working in the greater 18 Marietta region, not just on this case, but on 19 approximately seven others that kind of combine 20 into a southeast Ohio area improvements in 2.1 coordination with Buckeye Power and Washington 22 Electric to provide better service, more liable 23 service to the people of Marietta.
- So a lot of forethought has gone into the conclusions that we recommend here

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today.
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- Q. In addition to providing more reliable service do you anticipate economic benefits as a result of this development?
- 5 A. I think that conclusion could be drawn, yes.
- Q. Sir, do you believe this stipulation violates any regulatory practices or principle that you are aware of?
- 10 A. Not that I am aware of.
- MR. MARGARD: Thank you. Your
- 12 Honor, I have no further questions.
- 13 ALJ CATHCART: Thank you. Any
- 14 redirect?
- MS. BLEND: No, Your Honor. Thank
- 16 you.
- 17 ALJ CATHCART: You may be excused.

BLEND: No, Your Honor. 11 MR. MARGARD: None. 12 (WITNESS SWORN) 13 14 SHIRLEY DUCKWORTH 15 called as a witness, being first duly sworn, testified as follows: 16 17 ALJ CATHCART: Please state your 18 name and address for the court reporter. 19 MS. DUCKWORTH: Shirley Duckworth, 20 2780 Caywood Road, Marietta. 2.1 I did testify before, and I just 22 like to briefly say that my family has farmed the Duck Creek area for five generations. It 23 24 is not feasible to have these lines go through

our farm. It would be over probably a half mile

going through my entire farm on that one side.

As I would look out I would see them from Caywood to the top of the hill. They would be in my daughter's front yard, they would go down across our pond, which we use for recreation, and for watering our cattle.

I don't want to push this on to my neighbors' property, they don't want it anymore than me.

I question the real need for it in the township. I know you have to run these someplace in our area. Solar power is coming into use by farmers and industry and residents.

I just don't feel that it should be in our area. I just ask you folks would you look out your window and like to see this on property that wasn't there previously?

Would you buy a house with this in the side yard or in the back yard?

The value of our property is going down with this. It's disturbing our families, it's tearing up our homes. It's not a good thing.

And that is my last thought. Would you want this on your property, or would you
