18	Applicant will use inert gases or compressed air for all cleaning of pipes during construction, consistent with the NFPA 56 (PS) "Standard for Fire and Explosion Prevention During Cleaning and Purging of Flammable Gas Pipeline Systems."	<i>Completed</i>

Condition	Subject	Status
8	If any changes are made to the project layout after the submission of final engineering drawings, all changes shall be provided to Staff in hard copy and as geographically referenced electronic data. All changes outside the environmental survey areas and any changes within environmentally-sensitive areas shall be subject to Staff review and acceptance, to ensure compliance with all conditions of the certificate, prior to construction in those areas.	<i>Completed</i>
29	OPSB Staff, the ODNR Division of Wildlife (DOW), and the USFWS shall be contacted within 24 hours if state or federal threatened or endangered species are encountered during construction activities.  Construction activities that could adversely impact the identified plants or animals shall be halted until an appropriate course of action has been agreed upon by the Applicant, OPSB Staff, and the DOW in coordination with the USFWS.  Nothing in this provision shall preclude agencies having jurisdiction over the facility with respect to threatened or endangered species from exercising their legal authority over the facility consistent with law.	<i>Completed</i>
20	Applicant shall restrict public access to the facility with appropriately placed warning signs or other necessary measures.	<i>Completed</i>
