MS. BLEND: No objections, your Honor.

MR. PRITCHARD: No objections.

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1 MS. BOTSCHNER O'BRIEN: No objections. 2 EXAMINER SEE: Then ODSA Exhibits 1 and 2 3 and Joint Exhibit 1 are admitted into the record. (EXHIBITS ADMITTED INTO EVIDENCE.) 4 5 EXAMINER SEE: Mr. McNamee. 6 MR. McNAMEE: At this point it might be 7 useful for me to make an observation. The Bench will note that the Staff is not a signatory to the Joint 8 9 Stipulation. That should not be taken as indicating 10 any opposition whatsoever to the stipulation. 11 Rather, it represents the somewhat limited nature of 12 the Staff's involvement in these cases as the Bench 13 is well aware having done this for 18 years now, 14 the -- yeah, old enough to vote. 15 MS. MOONEY: But not legally. 16 MR. McNAMEE: Probably not. The Staff's 17 involvement in these cases is limited to a 18 mathematical review which has been performed. 19 are no mathematical problems in the presentation and 20 that's the extent of the Staff's involvement. It has 2.1 no opposition to the stipulation at all. 2.2 EXAMINER SEE: Thank you, Mr. McNamee. 23 Is there anything else? 24 Yes. 25 MS. BOTSCHNER O'BRIEN: Ohio Consumers'

Counsel would like to be on the record to say that we 1 2 are not signatories to the stipulation. We didn't 3 join the stipulation, but we do not oppose the stipulation at this time. 4 5 EXAMINER SEE: Thank you. 6 Ms. Mooney. 7 MS. MOONEY: Your Honor, OPAE is in the 8 same position as OCC. We are not a signatory party. 9 We are not opposing or supporting the stipulation, 10 and it is in the footnote of the... 11 EXAMINER SEE: Of the stipulation itself. 12 MS. MOONEY: Yes. 13 EXAMINER SEE: And in Ms. Meadows' 14 testimony so. 15 Anything further? 16 MR.
