- {¶ 2} On June 13, 2018, Mr. Michael Yemc, counsel for Mr. Bone, filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-13.
- $\{\P\ 3\}$ A prehearing settlement conference was held on August 8, 2018; however, the parties were unable to settle this matter.
- {¶ 4} Accordingly, this matter shall be set for hearing on November 8, 2018, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
- {¶ 5} Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-14(E) provides that a respondent who has requested an administrative hearing and fails to appear for the hearing shall be in default. The rule additionally states that a respondent in default shall be deemed to have admitted the occurrence of the violation and waived all further right to contest liability for the forfeiture proposed in the NPD.
- {¶ 6} At the hearing, Staff must prove, by a preponderance of the evidence, the occurrence of a violation, pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:2-7-20(A).
