## REVIEW AND RECOMMENDATION

SUBMITTED ON BEHALF OF THE STAFF OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO

On August 14, 2018, West Virginia PCS Alliance, L.C. (Applicant) filed a notice to cancel its registration 90-5447 pursuant to Ohio Adm. Code 4901:1-6-24. The Applicant was registered as a Commercial Mobile Radio Service (CMRS) provider in the state of Ohio on March 10, 2003.

The Applicant was acquired by Shenandoah Telecommunications Company and consolidated into its wholly owned subsidiary Shenandoah Personal Communications (Shentel). Through a contractual relationship with Sprint, Shentel deploys and operates a wireless network used by Sprint customers. As such, by the third quarter of 2017 all customers of the Applicant had been transitioned into the Sprint billing system. Therefore, the Applicant no longer needs to have registration in the State of Ohio.

Zero-day notices are made effective upon filing in accordance with the notice filing process described in rule 4901:1-6-05 of the O.A.C. Staff reviewed all documents filed with this notice and has determined that the proposed notice appears to satisfy the Commission's requirements set forth in 4901:1-6-24 of the Ohio Administrative Code. Staff recommends that this notice be made effective on August 14, 2018. Staff will cancel Registration No. 90-5447 and the associated TRF docket within ten business days.
