### ENTRY

{¶ 1} The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is an electric distribution utility as defined in R.C. 4928.01(A)(6), and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

{¶ 2} Pursuant to the directives of R.C. 4928.143(F), the Commission is required to evaluate the earnings of each electric utility's approved electric security plan to determine whether the plan or offer produces significantly excessive earnings for the electric utility.

{¶ 3} On May 15, 2017, DP&L filed an application for the administration of the significantly excessive earnings test, as required by R.C. 4928.143(F) and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-35-10 for 2016.

{¶ 4} On May 15, 2018, DP&L filed an application for the administration of the significantly excessive earnings test, as required by R.C. 4928.143(F) and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-35-10 for 2017.

{¶ 5} Accordingly, these matters should be set for hearing on October 23, 2018, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-C, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793. Interested persons may file motions to intervene no later than October 9, 2018, in each respective case. Direct testimony should be pre-filed by October 9, 2018, in each respective case.

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That a hearing be scheduled in accordance with Paragraph 5. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
