{¶ 1} Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. (Duke) is an electric distribution utility as defined in R.C 4928.01(A)(6), and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.

{¶ 2} Pursuant to the directives of R.C. 4928.143(F), the Commission is required to evaluate the earnings of each electric utility's approved electric security plan to determine whether the plan or offer produces significantly excessive earnings for the electric utility.

{¶ 3} On May 15, 2018, Duke filed an application for the administration of the significantly excessive earnings test, as required by R.C. 4928.143(F) and Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-35- 10 for 2016.

{¶ 4} On September 11, 2018, the attorney examiner issued a procedural schedule setting the matter for hearing on November 14, 2018.

{¶ 5} The attorney examiner finds that motions to intervene should be filed by October 4, 2018, testimony should be filed by November 7, 2018, and the evidentiary hearing should remain scheduled for November 14, 2018.

{¶ 6} It is, therefore,

{¶ 7} ORDERED, That the procedural schedule be set in accordance with Paragraph 5. It is, further,

{¶ 8} ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
