- {¶ 1} On September 4, 2018, Beebe 1B Renewable Energy, LLC (Applicant) filed an application in accordance with Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F) for certification as an Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, as defined in R.C. 4928.01. According to the application, Applicant operates a 50.4 megawatt wind-powered electric generation facility in Gratiot County, Ithaca, Michigan 48847.
- {¶ 2} Pursuant to Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F), Applicant's application is subject to a 60-day automatic approval process. Ohio Adm.Code 4901:1-40-04(F) further provides that, upon good cause shown, the Commission may suspend the certification of an application. If an application for certification is suspended, the Commission may act to approve or deny the application within 90 days of the suspension.
- {¶ 3} The attorney examiner finds that good cause exists to suspend the 60-day automatic approval process with respect to Applicant's application for certification. The Commission's Staff has requested additional time to review this application as it appears to present a new issue pertaining to the applicable tracking system and how the Applicant's eligibility may be impacted. Further, the attorney examiner instructs Applicant to file a response to Staff's initial inquiry within 30 days of the issuance of this Entry.
